
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST EUGENE MULVIHILL

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Eugene Mulvihill, a controlling shareholder, officer and director of Mayhill Agency Inc. and Seaboard Planning Corporation, registered broker-dealers.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that on February 27, 1985 Mulvihill was convicted, upon a plea of guilty in the Superior Court of New Jersey, of using a corporation to promote a criminal object (one count), falsifying and tampering with records (four counts), and illegally doing business as an unauthorized insurance company (one count).

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Mulvihill are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-23034)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

COMMODITY FUTURES POOL OPERATORS PLEAD GUILTY

The Seattle Regional Office and John E. Lamp, U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Washington, announced that on March 3 Orville W. Moeller and Bonnie E. Frost, of Moses Lake, Washington, pleaded guilty to two charges, fraud by a commodity pool operator and securities fraud, for their parts in a \$59 million commodity futures and securities fraud pyramid scheme involving about 1,200 investors. Frost was the owner of Basin Commodities, a Moses Lake representative for Saul Stone, a commodity futures brokerage firm based in Chicago, with Moeller acting as a commodities salesman through Basin. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SALOMON BROTHERS UNIT INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued granting Salomon Brothers Unit Investment Trust, Insured Tax-Exempt Series One and subsequent, similar series of trusts and their sponsor, Salomon Brothers Inc., exemption from the provisions of Section 11(c) of the Investment Company Act to permit certain exchange offers. STATE MUTUAL SECURITIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 14 to request a hearing on an application by State Mutual Securities, Inc. (Fund), State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America and its subsidiary, SMA Life Assurance Company, for an order to permit the Fund to acquire portfolio securities purchased by the subsidiary at direct placement. KEMPER INVESTMENT TRUST SERIES I AND SUBSEQUENT SERIES

An order has been issued exempting Kemper Investment Trust, Series I and Subsequent Series, a registered series unit investment trust, certain Kemper mutual funds and Kemper Sales Company, sponsor/depositor, from the provisions of Section 12(d)(1) of the Investment Company Act, and permitting the Trust Series to invest in zero-coupon obligations and underlying Fund shares. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-50) to amend its Rule 6.01 and establish new Rules 5.08 and 25, subsections .01 through .116, governing the trading of equity securities on the CBOE. (Rel. 34-23006); and The Cincinnati Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-CSE-86-2) to modify its trade-through and block trade policies. (Rel. 34-23008)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 17 and March 24, respectively.

(Company), Sohio Pipe Line Company, Standard Oil Company and The British Petroleum Company that the trusteeship of Chase Manhattan Bank under an existing indenture dated December 1, 1974 and the trusteeships of Chase under indentures dated January 1, 1970, August 15, 1975, February 1, 1976, May 1, 1976, July 1, 1982 and June 15, 1983 are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Chase from acting as trustee under any of such indentures.
