CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES HAWKINS & HAWKINS INVESTMENTS, OTHERS

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on November 28 a complaint was filed in the Federal District Court at Fort Worth, Texas, against Hawkins & Hawkins Investments, Kenneth Hawkins, and Luther Hawkins, all of Fort Worth. The complaint alleged that the defendants violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Investment Company Act of 1940 by offering and selling limited partnership interests to investors, and by pooling and investing the proceeds raised in call options. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, the defendants consented to a Final Order of Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint. The Order further requires the defendants to liquidate the portfolio investments and distribute the proceeds to investors. (SEC v. Hawkins & Hawkins Investments, et al., M.D. Tex./Fort Worth Division, Civil Action No. 4-80-420). (LR-9254)
