### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following stock exchanges have filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-82-19) to allow competitive traders or registered competitive market makers to initiate, while on the floor of the exchange, orders in stocks in which they have listed option positions. (Rel. 34-20006); The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-83-22) to move the expiration of the Standard & Poor's 100 (formerly the CBOE-100) index options to a February/May/August/November cycle. (Rel. 34-20007); (SR-CBOE-83-14) the Office and Business Equipment Industry Index, (SR-CBOE-83-15) the Oil (Integrated Domestic) Industry Index, (SR-CBOE-83-16) the Oil (Integrated International) Industry Index, (SR-CBOE-83-17) the Electronics Industry Index, and (SR-CBOE-83-18) the Brokerage

#### AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

#### FILING AND ORDER GRANTING ACCELERATED APPROVAL

The Commission has approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-83-15) to extend to December 6, 1983, the date by which SECO broker-dealers can apply for NASD membership under liberalized membership standards. To ensure membership in the NASD by that date, SECO broker-dealers must apply to the NASD before September 15, 1983. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
