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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### TREATS INTERNATIONAL ENTERPRISES, INC.

On September 3 the Commission issued an order denying the request of Treats International Enterprises, Inc. to make post-effective amendments to a registration statement effective pursuant to Section 8(c) of the Securities Act of 1933. (Rel 33-6955)

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### APPEAL OF GRAND SECURITIES COMPANY DISMISSED

The Commission has dismissed the appeal of Grand Securities Company, a broker-dealer located in Traverse City, Michigan, from a decision by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. denying it continued membership. The Commission found, as had the NASD, that Grand, as a successor to another member, had failed to meet pre-membership review requirements under Schedule C of the NASD By-Laws. In particular, the Commission noted that Grand had failed to demonstrate the adequacy and permanence of its net capital, and to submit to the NASD a satisfactory business plan and set of restrictions on its business. The Commission found that the grounds on which the NASD denied Grand membership existed in fact, that the denial of membership was in accordance with NASD rules, and that those rules were applied fairly. ### NASD ACTION AGAINST GORDON SODORFF, JR. AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed disciplinary action taken by the NASD against Gordon Wesley Sodorff, Jr. of Spokane, Washington, a former salesman for Dain Bosworth, Inc. The NASD censured Sodorff, fined him \$86,000, and barred him from association with any member of the NASD.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that despite restraints on Sodorff's outside activities imposed through a Consent Order with the Securities Division of the State of Washington Department of Licensing and his employment agreement with Dain, Sodorff entered into private business transactions without receiving approval from Dain and failed to provide Dain with prior written notification as required by the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. In addition, Sodorff unlawfully engaged in the securities business without being registered as a broker or dealer and deceived investors by failing to disclose that the stock he was selling had been purchased by him at prices considerably lower than the sales price.

In affirming the sanctions imposed by the NASD, the Commission stated that Sodorff's private sales deprived investors of expected protections and that his misrepresentations were, at a minimum, reckless. (Rel. 34-31134)

#### SETTLEMENT OFFER OF DAVID MARANTETTE III ACCEPTED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against David T. Marantette III and accepted Marantette's Offer of Settlement.

Marantette consented to the issuance of the Order, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. The Order contains findings that in 1986 Marantette, then Chairman of OTF Equities, Inc., a Detroit-based holding company, and Marantette & Company, a Detroit broker-dealer owned by Marantette, engaged in a scheme which involved the failure to properly close a \$4.5 million initial public offering of stock in Reuter Laboratories, Inc., an OTF subsidiary. This scheme resulted in false and misleading statements and inflated revenue in filings with the Commission by OTF and Comp-U-Check, Inc., another OTF subsidiary. The Order also contains findings that Marantette engaged in a scheme to inflate Comp-U-Check's reported net income by falsifying its financial statements in a quarterly report. Finally, the Order also contains findings, admitted by Marantette, that Marantette was the subject of an Order of Permanent Injunction by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan.

The Commission's Order bars Marantette from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-31136)

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#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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##### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC. ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 28 to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary, AEP Investments, Inc. AEP proposes to make capital contributions to AEP Investments in an aggregate amount of up to \$5 million through June 30, 1994. AEP Investments proposes to acquire through June 30, 1994 up to 50,000 shares of Intersource Technologies, Inc. preferred stock for an aggregate consideration of up to \$5 million. Intersource is a company engaged in the development of electronic light bulb technology. (Rel. 35-25620)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
