ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES BAZARIAN BARRED FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY PENNY STOCK OFFERING

The Commission accepted the offer of Charles Joseph Bazarian (Bazarian) to settle the administrative proceedings instituted September 6, 1995, and issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Bazarian. Bazarian consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the findings, except that he admitted the entry

of a judgment against him by the United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma which permanently enjoins him from future violations of the federal securities laws. The Order finds that Bazarian, through Royal American Management, Inc., a company he controlled, and others, offered and distributed approximately 1.6 million shares of the 2 million outstanding shares of Omnet Corporation and Performance Nutrition, Inc. at prices ranging from less than one dollar per share to nearly eight dollars per share, and approximately 3.8 million of the 4 million outstanding shares of Remington Financial Group, Inc. stock at prices ranging from less than fifty cents per share to more than four dollars per share. The Order bars Bazarian from participating in any offering of penny stock. (Rel. 34-36808)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN SKANDIA LIFE ASSURANCE CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 1 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Skandia Life Assurance Corporation (American Skandia), American Skandia Life Assurance Corporation Variable Account B (Class 1 Sub-Accounts) (Separate Account), and American Skandia Marketing, Inc. (Marketing) (collectively, Applicants). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), and 27(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would provide exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge and the recapture of certain credits applied to purchase payments from the assets of the Separate Account or any other separate account established by American Skandia to support certain individual and group flexible premium tax deferred variable annuity contracts (Contracts) as well as other variable annuity contracts that are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts (Future Contracts). In addition, Applicants propose that the order extend to any broker-dealer other than Marketing, that may in the future serve as principal underwriter for the Contracts or Future Contracts, the same exemptions granted to Marketing. Any such broker-dealer will be a member of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., and will be controlling, controlled by, or under common control with American Skandia. (Rel.
