ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

THE COMMISSION CENSURES HEIN + ASSOCIATES AND DUANE KNIGHT, JR. FOR VIOLATING INDEPENDENCE STANDARDS IN AUDIT

On July 2, the Commission instituted an administrative proceeding pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Hein + Associates LLP, a public accounting firm, and Duane C. Knight, Jr., a certified public accountant and former audit manager at Hein + Associates. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Hein + Associates and Knight consented to the issuance of an Opinion and Order of the Commission Imposing Sanctions Under Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. The Commission's Order finds that Knight engaged in improper professional conduct in connection with the audit of Mallon Resources Corporation's financial statements for 1993 by violating the independence standards of generally accepted auditing standards (GAAS). The Order finds that Knight, while an audit manager at Hein + Associates, continued to participate in the 1993 Mallon audit after receiving, and accepting, an offer of employment from Mallon. The Order finds that, as a result of Knight's involvement, Hein + Associates failed to maintain its independence from Mallon as required by GAAS, and issued an audit report which falsely stated that the audit of Mallon's financial statements for the year ended December 31, 1993 was performed in accordance with GAAS. In addition, the Order finds that Hein + Associates' failure to conduct an audit in accordance with GAAS constitutes improper professional conduct. The Commission's Order censures Hein + Associates and Knight and imposes remedial procedures upon Hein + Associates. (Rel. 34-37396; AAE Rel. 798)

FINAL JUDGMENTS OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND CIVIL PENALTIES ENTERED AGAINST DOUGLAS LAUGHLIN AND GEORGE ALAMA

The Commission announced that on June 19 the United States District Court for the Central District of California issued a Final Judgment Of Permanent Injunction And Civil Penalties against defendants Douglas Laughlin and George Alama, pursuant to their consents. Each of these defendants was ordered to pay \$7,500 in civil penalties.

The Commission's complaint, filed on September 6, 1995, named four other defendants and alleged that the principals of B.H. Rothchild & Gray (Canada) Lt'ee (B.H. Rothchild), raised approximately \$24 million from about 480 investors, during 1990-1992, from the United States and Canada, in connection with a purported seafood financing program, which was to involve B.H. Rothchild's subsidiary Ocean Best Seafood & Trading, Inc. However, the program was non-existent. Investor funds were used to pay other investors and for unauthorized business and personal expenses. Laughlin and Alama acted as unregistered broker-dealers in offering and selling interests in the financing program. [SEC v. Joy L. Bouwkamp et al., Civil Action 95-5975 JSL, SHx] (LR-14969)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC RESOURCES, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Electric System, a registered public-utility holding company, and its research and development subsidiary company, New England Electric Resources, Inc. (NEERI), whereby NEERI will make equity investments of up to \$1 million in a nonassociate company that is developing and commercializing power turbine vibration testing equipment. (Rel. 35-26539)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change 778 (SR-NASD-95-61) to amend NASD Rules 2820 and 2830 to revise existing rules applicable to the sale of investment company securities and establish new rules applicable to the sale of variable contract securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37374)

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-96-16) to provide that municipal securities are eligible for listing on the exchange. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37385)

The International Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-ISCC-96-03) relating to a change in the clearing fund. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37390; IS-999)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-Amex-96-22) filed by the American Stock Exchange to waive its equity transaction charges on proprietary equity trades in paired securities effected on the Exchange floor by options specialists and registered options traders, has become immediately effective. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37384)

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-96-31) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to set forth in two regulatory circulars its interpretation of how the firm quote rule should be administered and enforced in the trading crowd where options on the Standard and Poor's 100 Index (OEX options) are traded, has become immediately effective. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37388)

A proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-96-15) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to amend the PHLX Schedule of Fees and Charges relating to the current credit applicable to reducing charges associated with maintenance and operation of non-exchange sponsored security execution equipment by PHLX registered specialist firms operating on the PHLX equity trading floor (SR-PHLX-96-15) has become effective. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37389)

Delta Clearing Corp. filed a proposed rule change (SR-DCC-96-08) to give notice that it has authorized Patriot Securities, Inc. to act as an interdealer broker in DCC's system for clearance and settlement of U.S. Treasury repurchase and reverse repurchase agreement transactions. Publication is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 1. (Rel. 34-37392)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission is soliciting comment, and granting accelerated approval, to a proposal by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-96-27) to extend on an interim basis the OTC Bulletin Board Service through December 31, 1996. (Rel. 34-37387)
