COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TEMPORARY CHANGE IN OFFICE HOURS FOR ATLANTA DISTRICT OFFICE

Effective Friday, July 12, 1996, through Friday, August 9, 1996, the official business hours for the Atlanta District Office will be changed from 9:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (EST). This temporary change is made in cooperation with the City of Atlanta to minimize transportation difficulties for the staff during the period surrounding the Summer Olympic Games.

On Monday, August 12, 1996, official business hours for the Atlanta District Office will return to 9:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. (EST).

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE-AND-DESIST PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST IMS/CPAS & ASSOCIATES, VERNON HALL, STANLEY HARGRAVE AND JEROME VERNAZZA

The Commission announced that it instituted public administrative and cease-and-desist proceedings against IMS/CPAS & Associates (IMS), Vernon T. Hall (Hall), Stanley E. Hargrave (Hargrave) and Jerome B. Vernazza (Vernazza) (collectively Respondents) pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Section 203(e) (with regard to IMS and Vernazza), 203(f) (with regard to Vernazza, Hargrave and Mall) and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act).

The Order Instituting Proceedings (Order) alleges that the Respondents, an investment adviser and its associated persons, recommended to their clients that they invest in an investment company whose adviser was paying TMS a fee based upon a percentage of the assets IMS' clients invested. In addition, the fees were used to reduce a debt IMS owed the investment company's adviser. IMS falsely stated in materials disseminated to its clients and in registration statements filed with the Commission that IMS was not receiving any compensation for these recommendations. Moreover, IMS failed to disclose to clients the existence of its debt to the adviser.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine if the staff's allegations are true and, if so, whether cease and desist orders, remedial sanctions, accountings, disgorgement and civil penalties are appropriate against the Respondents. (Rel. 33-7310; 34-37423; IA-1570)

CEASE-AND-DESIST ORDER ISSUED AGAINST ALEXANDER SHESHUNOFF

The Commission announced that an Order Instituting Public Proceedings pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 was issued against Alexander Sheshunoff, Sr. (Sheshunoff) of Austin, Texas. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Sheshunoff's Offer of Settlement in which he consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the entry of an Order directing him to cease and desist from any violation of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act.

This matter involved Sheshunoff's manipulation of the closing price of the common stock of Business Records Corporation (BRC), which is traded on NASDAQ. The Commission found that Sheshunoff "marked the close," or attempted to influence the closing price, of BRC stock by placing orders to buy small lots at prices \$.125 to \$1 per share higher than the last previously reported trade. Over a five-year period, from July 1990 through April 1995, Sheshunoff executed 326 trades in BRC stock, 52 percent of which were the last trade of the day, and 66 percent of which were either the last trade or occurred after 3:30 p.m.

The Commission further found that Sheshunoff's end-of-day trades increased the closing price of BRC stock and thereby increased the equity in margin accounts where he held substantial positions in the stock. Sheshunoff's increased account equity served to satisfy or reduce margin maintenance calls in his accounts and to avoid additional calls. (Rel. 34-37419)

ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE-AND-DESIST PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST AL RIZEK

The Commission announced that it instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and cease-and desist proceedings pursuant to Section 21C of the Exchange Act against Al Rizek (Rizek) of Condado, Puerto Rico. Rizek is alleged to have willfully violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by churning the accounts of certain of his customers during at least the period from January 1, 1993 to March 31, 1994. COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC., ET AL.

Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and thirty-three subsidiary companies, to include Columbia Service Partners, Inc. and TriStar System, Inc. as potential investors in the Money Pool and, through December 31, 1996, to include in the Money Pool as potential investors any new direct or indirect subsidiaries engaged in new lines of business established pursuant to an order of the Commission or any new direct or indirect subsidiaries engaged in existing lines of business. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Mortgage Backed Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-MBSCC-96-03) to eliminate the requirements that MBSCC provide a monthly audit package to each participant and that such participant review and respond to its monthly audit package. (Rel. 34-37420)
