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## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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### JOHN HALL, JR. AND ROGER BISHOP INDICTED

The Commission and the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas announced that on August 21 a grand jury returned a 26-count indictment against John Allen Hall, Jr. (Hall), and Roger Alan Bishop (Bishop). Hall and Bishop were charged with wire fraud, mail fraud, the sale of non-exempted securities by an unregistered broker or dealer, and money laundering.

The criminal charges against Hall and Bishop relate to the same activities alleged in the Commission's civil action filed April 24, 1992. According to the Commission's complaint, Hall and Bishop participated in fraudulent sale of unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts in an investment pool purportedly formed to finance transactions in the import and export of commodities. Further, the complaint alleged that Hall, Bishop, and others, lied to investors concerning the use of investor proceeds, the profits and earnings to be realized, and the risks associated with the investment. Without admitting or denying the allegations, Hall and Bishop consented to be permanently enjoined from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws on July 24, 1994 and December 23, 1993, respectively. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### ENTERGY CORP., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by Entergy Arkansas, Inc. (Arkansas), Entergy Gulf States, Inc. (Gulf States), Entergy Louisiana, Inc. (Louisiana), Entergy Mississippi, Inc. (Mississippi), Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (New Orleans), and System Energy Resources, Inc. (System Energy), all public utility subsidiary companies of Entergy Corp. (Entergy), a registered holding company, to finance, through November 30, 2001, their interim capital needs through loans from the Entergy system money

pool and through the issuance and sale of unsecured short-term notes and commercial paper. The maximum amount of loans, notes, and commercial paper that each could issue is limited to: Arkansas, \$235 million; Gulf States, \$340 million; Louisiana, \$225 million; Mississippi, \$103 million; New Orleans, \$35 million; and System Energy, \$140 million.

In addition, Entergy Services, Inc. (ESI), a service company subsidiary, System Fuels, Inc. (SFI), a fuel supply subsidiary, and Entergy Operations, Inc. (EOI), a public utility subsidiary, propose to borrow, through November 30, 2001, through the money pool, from Entergy, and/or from commercial banks, up to a maximum principal amount outstanding of \$150 million, \$95 million and \$20 million, respectively. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board has filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-96-06) relating to telemarketing rules. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 2. (Rel. 34-37626)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange to amend its Schedule of Rates for Exchange Services by reducing the current cap on transaction charges for equity block trades and by adopting a transaction fee cap per 100 shares for equity securities. (SR-PSE-96-27) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 2. (Rel. 34-37627)
