ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

STEVEN KOINIS CONSENTS TO CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AND CIVIL PENALTY FOR ROLE IN OCTAGON DISCLOSURES

On May 29, the Commission filed with the United States District Court for the District of Columbia a proposed final judgment imposing a \$35,000 civil penalty against Steven W. Koinis, formerly the President and Chief Operating Officer of Octagon, Inc. and a member of the company's board of directors. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint in the case, which was filed on March 14, 1997, Koinis has consented to entry of the proposed final judgment.

The Commission's complaint alleged that Koinis violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Exchange Act Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-2 by making materially false and misleading public disclosures on behalf of Octagon. More specifically, the complaint alleged that Koinis failed to make timely and accurate disclosures about material related-party transactions between Octagon and PRK Group, Inc., a company of which Koinis's wife was a one-third owner, and that he made materially false and misleading disclosures about a major contract between Octagon and James Mackenzie International Trading PLC (JMIT). The complaint also alleged that Koinis failed to tell Octagon's all material facts about Octagon's contractual accountants relationships with PRK Group and JMIT.

In a related matter, the Commission issued an administrative order pursuant to Section 21C of the Exchange Act against Koinis, finding that he violated Exchange Act Section 10(b) and Exchange Act Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-2 and ordering him to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of those provisions. Without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the Commission's order, Koinis consented to its entry. [SEC v. Steven W. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST TED WESTERFIELD

On May 23, the Honorable John S. Martin, U.S.D.J., granted the Commission's summary judgment motion and determined that Westerfield violated antifraud provisions of the securities laws by engaging in a commission kickback scheme. Westerfield, a broker with Gruntal & Co., agreed to kick back a portion of commissions he earned on the purchase and sale of high yield bonds ordered by Albert Griggs, Jr., a bond analyst and assistant portfolio manager with Keystone Custodian Funds, Inc.

The Commission had charged that the scheme defrauded both Keystone and its mutual fund investors, because its purpose was to enrich Westerfield and Griggs rather than obtain best execution of transactions for the Keystone investors. Keystone investors also were defrauded in that they were not informed that Keystone, in exercising its investment advisory function, had agreed to execute purchases and sales of high yield bonds for Keystone's account through Westerfield, pursuant to his undisclosed kickback arrangement with Griggs.

The Court ordered disgorgement of \$210,931, representing commissions he received as a result of the scheme, and prejudgment interest of \$133,896, for a total of \$344,827. The Court also determined to enjoin Westerfield from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act, Rule 10b-5 thereunder, Section 204 of the Investment Advisers Act, Rule 204-1 thereunder, and Section 17(e)(1) of the Investment Company Act. The Court based its determination on a jury verdict in a related criminal case, <u>US v. Westerfield</u>, 95 Cr. 219 (LMM), in which Westerfield was sentenced to 15 months of incarceration and restitution of \$105,465.50. [SEC v. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST JUDY HOCKETT, GAYLE RAISOR AND KEVIN RAISOR

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana against Judy Hockett, Gayle Raisor, and Kevin Raisor alleging violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by engaging in insider trading. The complaint alleges that while in possession of material, nonpublic information concerning pending the pending acquisition of an 80% interest in Adesa Corp. by Minnesota Power and Light, obtained from her husband, the chief executive officer of Adesa, Judy Hockett tipped her brother Gayle Raisor who purchased Adesa common stock. Gayle Raisor then tipped his son Kevin Raisor who also purchased shares of Adesa common stock. From their illegal trades in Adesa, Gayle Raisor and Kevin Raisor realized illegal profits of \$25,500 and \$4,800, respectively.

Simultaneously, and without admitting or denying the allegations, Judy Hockett, Gayle Raisor, and Kevin Raisor consented to the entries of final judgments enjoining each of them from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, ordering Gayle Raisor and Kevin Raisor to disgorge \$25,500 and \$4,800, respectively, with prejudgment interest thereon, and to pay a one-time civil penalty. Judy Hockett, who did not trade in the securities of Adesa, is ordered by the Final Judgments jointly and severally liable with Gayle Raisor and Kevin Raisor for the disgorgement of their trading profits and to disgorge \$30,300, prejudgment interest thereon, and to pay a one time civil penalty in the amount of \$30,300. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PACIFICA FUNDS TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pacifica Funds Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-22686 - May 28)

BOND FUND SERIES, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Bond Fund Series, et al. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 13(a)(2), 13(a)(3), 18(a), 18(c), 18(f)(1), 22(f), 22(g), and 23(a) of the Act and Rule 2a-7 thereunder, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act for an exemption from Section 17(a)(1) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The order permits certain registered investment companies to enter into deferred fee arrangements with their trustees, directors, and general partners who are not interested persons within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Act. PROJECT CAPITAL 1995, LLC

An order has been issued under Sections 6(b) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Project Capital 1995, LLC. The order grants an exemption to Project Capital 1995, LLC, from all provisions of the Act except Section 9, certain provisions of Section 17 (other than certain provisions of Sections 17(a), (d), (f), (g) and (j)), Section 30 (other than certain provisions of Sections 30(a), (b), (e) and (h)), Sections 36 through 53, and the rules and regulations thereunder. The order permits certain affiliated and joint transactions incident to the creation and operation of employees' securities companies within the meaning of Section 2(a)(13) of the Act. (Rel. MERRILL LYNCH KECALP L.P. 1997 AND KECALP INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1997 (1997 Partnership) and KECALP Inc., under Section

6(b) of the Investment Company Act. The order amends a prior order to permit Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc. and its affiliates to acquire limited partnership interests in the 1997 Partnership and in any similar partnership commencing operations in the future. Each Partnership will be an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a)(13) of the Act. (Rel. IC-22689 - May 28)

CORE TRUST (DELAWARE), ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Core Trust (Delaware), et al. under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order permits: a series of Core Trust to acquire all of the assets and assume all of the liabilities of another series of Core Trust; and a series of Norwest Advantage Funds to transfer all of its assets to a series of Core Trust in exchange for an interest in that series of Core Trust. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-22690 - May 28)

NEW USA MUTUAL FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of she Investment Company Act exempting New USA Mutual Funds, Inc., et al. from Section 15(f)(1)(A). The order permits O'Neil Data Systems, Inc., the parent and sole stockholder of New USA Research & Management Co., the investment manager of the New USA Growth Fund, to receive compensation in connection with the sale of New USA Growth Fund's net assets to MFS Series Trust II (MFS Series II), without requiring MFS Series II to reconstitute its board of directors. Without the requested exemption, MFS Series II would have to reconstitute its board of directors to meet the 75 percent non-interested director requirement of Section 15(f)(1)(A) in order to comply with the safe harbor provisions of Section 15(f). ENTERPRISE GROUP OF FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Enterprise Group of Funds, Inc., et al. from Section 15(f)(1)(A). The order permits the investment adviser of four funds of Retirement System Fund Inc. to receive compensation in connection with the sale of the funds' net assets to Enterprise of Funds, (Enterprise Funds), Group Inc. without requiring Enterprise Funds to reconstitute its board of directors. Without the requested exemption, Enterprise Funds would have to reconstitute its board of directors to meet the 75 percent non-interested director requirement of Section 15(f)(1)(A) in order to comply with the safe harbor provisions of Section 15(f). SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-97-24) to adopt a rule codifying policies and procedures relating to its Automated Options Market (AUTOM) and to request permanent approval of the AUTOM pilot program. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 2. (Rel. 34-38683)
