COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ANNOUNCES PILOT SECURITIES ARBITRATION CLINIC TO HELP SMALL INVESTORS; LEVITT RESPONDS TO CONCERNS VOICED AT TOWN MEETINGS

Chairman Levitt announced today the start of pilot securities arbitration clinics at two New York law schools -- Pace University and Fordham University -- to help small investors who have difficulty obtaining legal representation.

The clinics were started in response to concerns expressed to Chairman Levitt by small investors at several SEC town meetings. Because their claims are often not large enough, it is difficult for small investors to obtain counsel to represent them in arbitration. To help solve this problem, the Commission is working with law schools in the New York City area to set up pilot arbitration clinics. Students in the pilot programs will, under supervision of a lawyer, assist small investors in the securities arbitration process. (Press Rel. 97-101)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER GRANTED IN PRIME BANK CASE

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint on November 5 against Teddy Wayne Solomon and Lisa Stevens, individually and d/b/a Platinum International Associates, and Quantum Group, a/k/a Quantum Trading, Ltd. After a hearing on the filing date, the Honorable Barefoot Sanders issued an order providing emergency relief in the form of a order temporarily restraining defendants from violating the federal securities laws, imposing an asset freeze and requiring an interim accounting. The complaint also seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions, disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, and the appointment of a receiver.

The complaint alleges the defendants are violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by offering and selling interests in fictitious "Prime Bank Instrument" trading programs. The complaint further alleges that Solomon and Stevens represented,

among other things, that they were agents for foreign securities traders trading in large-denomination debt instruments issued by "one of the top 25 world banks," and that an investment in the trading programs would generate "safe, guaranteed" returns of as much as 4,300% annually. Additionally, the complaint alleges that Solomon's and Stevens' representations were false: the trading programs do not exist, and Solomon and Stevens, in an apparent "Ponzi scheme" have used funds taken from investors to pay putative profits to their business associates, to repay other investors, and for their own purposes. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENTERGY LONDON INVESTMENTS PLC

An order has been issued authorizing Entergy London Investments plc, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to organize a special purpose financing entity and, through it, to issue and sell one or more series of preferred securities in an aggregate principal amount up to \$500 million, through December 31, 2000. CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST SERVICES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 1, 1997 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Services, Inc. (CSWS), a non-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to license and sell to non-associate entities through December 31, 2002 specialized computer programs and to provide support services to licensees and entities that purchase such software. CSWS also seeks authorization to sell reserve computer capacity and provide data management services to non-associate entities. (Rel. 35-26776)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-40) to define the phrase "terms and conditions of an order" for purposes of the Exchange's rules on solicited trades and crossed trades.
