COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ANITA NAGLER RECEIVES AWARD

Anita M. Nagler, Associate Regional Administrator of the Commission's Chicago Regional Office, has been recognized by the William A. Jump Memorial Foundation "for exemplary service in public administration." The Foundation presents awards to outstanding federal employees in memory of William A. Jump, who served for many years as the distinguished Budget and Finance Officer of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NORMAN L. DIXON AND DAVID N. GLIKSMAN BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Norman L. Dixon (Dixon), formerly a registered representative with a broker-dealer in Iowa, and David N. Glikzman (Glikzman), formerly a registered representative with a broker-dealer in California. Dixon and Glikzman submitted Offers of Settlement consenting to the entry of Orders which contain findings that, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, on June 10, 1991, Dixon and Glikzman were permanently enjoined by final judgment of the United States District Court for the Central District of California [SEC v. David D. Sterns, et al., Civil Action No. 91-1303-ER, C.D. Cal., June 10], from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act. The Orders permanently bar Dixon and Glikzman from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
