## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### STOP ORDER PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST PETROFAB INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The Commission issued an Order Fixing Time and Place of Public Hearing under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 to determine whether a Stop Order should be issued suspending the effectiveness of the registration statement filed by Petrofab International, Inc. of Seattle, Washington. The hearing is set for 10:00 a.m., January 29, at the Seattle Regional Office, 3040 Federal Office Building, 915 Second Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98174.

The Commission initiated the proceeding because of alleged untrue, false and misleading statements made in and omissions in the registration statement. (Rel. 33-6564)

### THOMSON MCKINNON SECURITIES, INC. CENSURED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Thomas McKinnon Securities, Inc., a registered New York, New York broker-dealer. On September 10 and 17, 1982, Thomson allegedly used approximately \$18.6 and \$20.7 million, respectively, of its customers' fully-paid and/or excess margin securities to execute the firm's stock loan transactions. The Order also alleges that Thomson violated certain bookkeeping and supplemental reporting provisions of the Exchange Act.

Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Thomson providing for findings, without admitting or denying, that Thomson violated the customer protection, bookkeeping, and supplemental reporting rules; censuring Thomson; requiring the firm to maintain certain procedures relating to its stock loan operations and to retain a firm of independent public accountants to monitor Thomson's compliance with said procedures, and report its findings to the Commission for two years; and a voluntary undertaking by Registrant to make a contribution of ten days' net earnings from its stock loan operations to the Securities Investor Protection Corporation. ## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### OREGON INVESTMENT ADVISER PLEADS GUILTY

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on January 8 Curtis Allen Wolfer, a registered investment adviser from Silverton, Oregon, pleaded guilty to one count of fraud under the Investment Advisers Act and one count of failing to file a tax return arising from a 17-count indictment filed against him on August 16, 1983. The indictment charged Wolfer, a former member of the Oregon State Legislature, with executing a scheme to defraud investors by organizing and controlling certain corporations and limited partnerships which accepted investor funds for reinvestment in stocks, bonds, commodities and commodities futures contracts. The indictment further charged that Wolfer was sending each investor a periodic statement of his or her account which was false in that the statements represented an investment value substantially greater than the investor's actual investment. ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### ARKANSAS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 19 to request a hearing on a proposal by Arkansas Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell through February 28, 1987 up to \$200 million of first mortgage bonds and one or more series of its preferred stock, \$25 or \$100 par value, the total number of such shares sold not to exceed \$100 million aggregate par value. ## NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 19 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to an aggregate of 4,843,077 shares of additional common stock, \$5 par value, through December 31, 1988 under its existing Dividend Reinvestment and Common Stock Purchase Plan. ### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-84-24) to extend the PSE's pilot program for the appointment and evaluation of specialists and the creation of new specialist posts for a three-month period from December 31, 1984 to March 31, 1985. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-84-31) that would modify Schedule D of its By-Laws by providing that an American Depository Receipt (ADR) registered under Section 12(g) of the Act may be included in the NASD Automated Quotations System if at least 100,000 ADRs have been registered with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of January 28. (Rel. 34-21685)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change (SR-OCC-84-19) implements a final On-Line Service Supplement to the Agreement for OCC Services to replace the Pilot Agreement for OCC's On-Line Program. (Rel. 34-21686)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
