CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST MONARCH FUNDING CORP., OTHERS

The Commission filed a complaint on September 9 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Monarch Funding Corp., a registered New York, New York broker-dealer; Richard O. Bertoli, of Sparkill, New York; Leo M. Eisenberg, of Woodmere, New York, Monarch's president; Richard M. Cannistraro, of New York, New York; and Steven R. Cloyes, of Katonah, New York.

The complaint alleges, among other things, that: the defendants violated the anti-fraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Acts; Cannistraro violated the anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act [these violations took place in connection with the initial public offerings of Liquidation Control, Inc. (LCI) in December 1982 and of Toxic Waste Containment, Inc. in March 1983, underwritten by Monarch]; the defendants manipulated the market in these securities by dominating the market and controlling the supply of LCI and Toxic securities; and the defendants caused to be issued materially false and misleading investment recommendations for LCI and Toxic securities.

The complaint requests that the Court issue Orders permanently enjoining the defendants from further violations of these provisions, and that Monarch, Bertoli and Eisenberg be directed to disgorge illegally obtained profits in excess of \$4 million. (SEC v. Monarch Funding Corp., et al., 85 C.A. No. 7072 [L. Sand]). (LR-10864)

HYDRO-WAVE CORPORATION, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office filed a complaint on August 23 in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee against Hydro-Wave Corporation (HWC), Albert G. Lemmons and W. Thomas Jones alleging violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Acts. Without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, the defendants consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief, which was signed by the Court on August 29.

The complaint alleges that beginning in mid-1982 and continuing up to at least early 1984, the defendants sold approximately 3.5 million shares of HWC to over 1,000 investors residing in at least 30 states for over \$3 million. In effecting these sales, the complaint alleges that the defendants made numerous misrepresentations of material fact and omitted to state facts concerning, among other things, the financial condition of HWC; the use of proceeds from the sale of shares of stock of HWC; that Lemmons and Jones were selling their own stock and retaining most of the proceeds; that HWC was experiencing a negative cash flow; and that the investment involved a high degree of risk. (SEC v. Hydro-Wave Corporation, et al., USDC MDTN, Nashville Division, Civil Action No. 3-85-0979). (LR-10865)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Massachusetts Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to issue up to \$2 million in loans in a Pilot Program to finance conservation measures to be taken by certain of its customers. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company and Pennsylvania Electric Company, subsidiaries of General Public Utilities, to amend a credit agreement to reimburse the banks for the increased costs incurred in making, funding or maintaining DMM-Bid Rate borrowings under the credit agreement which result from any change in law or governmental regulation or the compliance therewith by any bank. VERMONT YANKEE NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation to issue not more than \$75 million in principal amount of short-term debt to be evidenced either by promissory notes to a group of major international banks, or by commercial paper to be sold to Paine Webber, Inc., for resale to its customers. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
