ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD DIRECTED TO BAR ADRIAN ANTONIU

The Commission issued an order directing the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. to bar Adrian Antoniu, a person subject to a statutory disqualification as a result of his criminal conviction for violation of the insider trading prohibitions, from becoming associated with an NASD member firm that had proposed to employ him. The NASD had given the Commission notice that it proposed to permit Antoniu to become associated with its member firm unless directed otherwise by the Commission. (Rel. 34-22383)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PARADYNE CORPORATION PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on September 9 Judge William J. Castagna, U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida, entered a Final Order permanently enjoining Paradyne Corporation, of Largo, Florida, from violating certain anti-fraud and reporting provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and certain rules. Paradyne consented to the order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The March 25, 1983 complaint alleged that Paradyne had violated the antifraud and reporting provisions by misrepresenting and failing to disclose material facts, in various filed and published documents, relating to an \$84 million contract it was awarded in 1981 by the Social Security Administration. Trial of the case had been scheduled for September 11, 1985. (SEC v. Paradyne Corporation, USDC MDFL, Civil Action No. 83-351-Civ-T-10). (LR-10866)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL SERIES TRUST

An order has been issued granting Merrill Lynch California Municipal Series Trust (Applicant) exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 2(a)(41), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1. The exemption will permit Applicant to assess (and in certain cases waive) a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares of Applicant's Merrill Lynch California Tax-Exempt Fund. MERRILL LYNCH, PIERCE, FENNER & SMITH INCORPORATED

An order has been issued on an application filed by Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated, Prudential-Bache Securities Inc., Shearson Lehman Brothers Inc., Dean Witter Reynolds Inc. and PaineWebber Incorporated (Sponsors) and certain investment companies of the Sponsors amending prior Commission orders approving certain offers of exchange, and approving certain offers of exchange. PRUDENTIAL-BACHE GLOBAL FUND, INC.

An order has been issued on an application of Prudential-Bache Global Fund, Inc., Prudential-Bache Government Plus Fund, Inc. and Prudential-Bache Securities, Inc. amending an existing Commission order to permit the further reduction and waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of their shares under certain circumstances. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in nine issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 by The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.: (SR-NASD-85-22) to amend its Certificate of Incorporation which presently permits the NASD to transact business in the United States. The proposed rule change deletes the reference to the United States thereby enabling the NASD to transact business anywhere it chooses. (Rel. 34-22399); and (SR-NASD-85-6) which amends its Venture Capital Restrictions. This rule change provides exemptions from venture capital limitations if the underwriter meets certain conditions. If an underwriter does not qualify for these exemptions, the rule change would continue to prohibit an underwriter from selling its shares during an offering period but would reduce the lock-up period from one year to 90 days. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by Pacific Clearing Corporation and Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company (SR-PCC-85-5; SR-PSDTC-85-7) to establish settlement and distribution services for certain underwritings of PSDTC-eligible securities. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 9. (Rel. 34-22400)
