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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### BSECC ACTION AGAINST WILLIAM H. RYBECK & CO. AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the Boston Stock Exchange Clearing Corporation (BSECC) on William H. Rybeck & Co., Inc., a Meriden, Connecticut brokerage firm. The BSECC fined the firm \$1,000, placed it on probation for one year, and required it to submit copies of the monthly FOCUS reports that Rybeck submits to the NASD.

The Commission found, as had the BSECC, that on June 8, 1984, Rybeck failed to make timely payment of settlement charges due the BSECC. In light of the firm's lengthy prior history of late settlement payments, the Commission found no basis for concluding that the sanctions imposed by the BSECC were excessive or oppressive. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### APPLICATION FILED FOR ORDER ADJUDGING ELBEE INTERNATIONAL, INC., OTHERS

The Commission filed an application on November 19 for an Order adjudging Elbee International, Inc., a New Jersey corporation (Elbee-USA), Elbee International, Inc., a Panama corporation (Elbee-Panama), and Harshad K. Shah in civil contempt of the Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief (Final Judgment) issued by the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia on May 20, 1985. Elbee-USA, Elbee-Panama and Shah consented to the Final Judgment which enjoined them from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and ordered them to disgorge \$362,007 and \$678,001, which represent the amounts of funds received from the investors in Elbee-USA and Elbee-Panama, respectively, plus interest accrued on such funds.

The papers filed by the Commission allege that Elbee-USA, Elbee-Panama and Shah failed to place into escrow and disgorge the funds illegally obtained from investors as required by the Final Judgment. The Commission seeks an Order for Civil Contempt for violating and disobeying the Court's Final Judgment, and an Order requiring Elbee-USA, Elbee-Panama and Shah each to pay \$1,000 per day into the registry of the Court until the disgorgement is made. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### HUGHES AIRCRAFT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hughes Aircraft Company, Hughes Aircraft Company Long-Term Incentive Plan (Plan) and Hughes Aircraft Company Long-Term Incentive Plan Trust (Trust) requesting an order exempting the Plan and the Trust from all provisions of the Investment Company Act (with certain exceptions) and granting confidential treatment for certain reports. ### THE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF VIRGINIA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13 to request a hearing on an amendment to an application filed by The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, Life of Virginia Separate Account I and Life of Virginia Security Sales, Ltd. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 6e-3(T) in the issuance of certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. ## IDS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by IDS Life Insurance Company, IDS Life Insurance Company of New York, et al., requesting an order exempting them from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit a reorganization involving the combination of certain separate accounts of both IDS Life Insurance Company, IDS Life Insurance Company of New York. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### SOUTHERN ELECTRIC INTERNATIONAL, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Southern Electric International, Inc., subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell unsecured notes from time to time prior to October 1, 1987, with maturities no later than December 31, 2000, in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$75 million at any one time outstanding, and for Southern to acquire and/or guarantee some or all of the notes. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the issuance and sale of some of the notes to non-affiliates. (Rel. 35-23911 - Nov. 18)

### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and its wholly-owned service company, American Electric Power Service Corporation (AEPSC). It is proposed that AEPSC issue letters of credit or surety bonds to certain insurance companies to maintain the currently existing workmen's compensation program and general and automobile liability insurance program and to put into effect certain provisions of the group medical plan. AEP proposes to guarantee the obligations of AEPSC respecting the letters of credit or surety bonds or, in the alternative, obtain such letters of credit or surety bonds itself on behalf of AEPSC. ### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, to extend the period in which to issue and sell NEES common shares, under the New England Electric System Dividend Reinvestment and Common Share Purchase Plan, through December 31, 1988. 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## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

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### DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike all put and call option contracts respecting U.S. Treasury Notes with the 11-1/4% coupon, due May 15, 1985. (Rel. 34-22635)

### UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of one issue (each application) which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-41) to reinstate sequential opening rotations in equity options with the nearest expiration month opening first, then proceeding to the series of options having the next most distant expiration, and so forth, until all series have been opened. ## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Boston Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-85-8) that will codify its current policy of allowing trades to be effected on the stock exchange floor for "next-day" settlement periods, defined to include the first through fourth day after trade date.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 18. (Rel. 34-22638)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
