ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

DOMINICK J. FIORESE SANCTIONED

The New York Regional Office announced that in public administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Section 14(b) of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 (SIPA), Dominick J. Fiorese, president of Southeast Securities of Florida, Inc. (Registrant), a registered Hoboken, New Jersey broker-dealer, submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Fiorese, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to a Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds that he wilfully aided and abetted Registrant's violations of the recordkeeping, preservation of records, financial reporting, supplemental reporting and amendment of Form BD provisions of the Exchange Act, and that he was the president, director, a shareholder and controlling person of Registrant, for which a trustee was appointed under SIPA. The Commission barred Fiorese from being associated with any broker-dealer in any proprietary or a supervisory capacity respecting financial, bookkeeping and back office functions, provided that after five years from the date of the Order, he may apply to become associated in any such capacities. BHP FINANCE (USA) INC.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SYSTEM FUELS, INC.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Pacific Clearing Corporation and the Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company filed proposed rule changes (SR-PCC-85-9; SR-PSDTC-85-10) to reduce the number of directors on PCC's and PSDTC's Boards of Directors to between 10 and 13 directors, down from between 12 and 15 directors. The proposals also would delete authority of PCC's or PSDTC's Boards of Directors to set the exact number of directors and vest that authority with shareholders.

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 25. (Rel. 34-22652)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-24) to establish a simplified procedure for the disposition of minor rule violations under Article XI, Section 2 of the Exchange Constitution. (Rel. 34-22653)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED PLAN

The Commission approved a proposed plan filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. specifying those uncontested minor rule violations with sanctions not exceeding \$2,500 which would be subject to abbreviated quarterly reporting to the Commission under Rule 19d-1(c)(2). (Rel. 34-22654)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
