CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS GILMARTIN, JR., ET AL. ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on December 4 a complaint was filed in the United States District Court in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, charging registered representatives Thomas P. Gilmartin, Jr. (Gilmartin) and Terence W. Zawacki (Zawacki) with violations of the federal securities laws.

During the relevant time period, defendants Gilmartin and Zawacki were employed by First Ohio Securities Company (First Ohio), a registered broker-dealer owned by Gilmartin. The complaint alleges that Gilmartin, through First Ohio and aided and abetted by Zawacki, offered and sold to the public approximately \$6 million in unregistered securities and defrauded investors by misappropriating the proceeds from the sale of these and other securities. The complaint further alleges that in furtherance of this fraudulent scheme, Gilmartin and Zawacki aided and abetted First Ohio's net capital and books and records violations of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; that Gilmartin aided and abetted violations of certain books and records provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940; and that Gilmartin directly violated the registration, antifraud and books and records provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. BOILER ROOM OPERATOR HELD IN CIVIL CONTEMPT

The Honorable Mary Little Parell of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey issued an Order Adjudging Arden R. Brown In Civil Contempt of a July 17, 1991 Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Order of Disgorgement by Consent (Final Judgment), for failing to pay disgorgement in accordance with the terms of the Final Judgment. The Final Judgment ordered Arden R. Brown (Brown) to disgorge to the U.S. Treasury a total of \$201,793.64 in 24 monthly installments.

Judge Parell ordered Brown to pay \$60,000 to the U.S. Treasury on or before March 12, 1993. Judge Parell further ordered that should Brown fail to pay the \$60,000 within the prescribed time period, a bench warrant will issue for his arrest and incarceration. Judge Parell further ordered Brown to pay the remaining disgorgement in a series of monthly installments. Should Brown fail to make any monthly installment payment, the Commission will have leave to reapply to the Court for contempt and sanctions on 24 hours notice.

The Final Judgment permanently enjoined Brown from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with his operation of the now defunct "boiler room" broker-dealer, Monmouth Investments, Inc. [SEC v. Beres Industries, Inc., et al., 90 Civ. 3260, MLP, USDC DNJ] (LR-13516)

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST SHARON VAN DEN BERG BAKER, ET AL.

The Commission announced that on January 15, 1993 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Sharon V. Baker (Baker), a registered investment adviser residing in Hypoluxo, Florida. The Court also entered orders freezing Baker's assets and appointing a receiver.

The Commission's complaint in this matter, filed on January 15, 1993, alleges that from at least August 1991 through at least December 1992, Baker misrepresented to clients that she was investing their money in low risk, high interest, tax-free money market funds and notes. In fact, she was using the monies for, among other things, personal expenses. The complaint also alleges that Baker misrepresented her educational background; did not disclose that in December 1990, the New York Stock Exchange barred her from association with any member organization; and violated disclosure and recordkeeping provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. On January 25, 1993, the Court entered a judgment of preliminary injunction and other relief, by consent, as to Baker, SECIA, and the Special Account. [SEC v. Sharon Van den Berg Baker, et al., USDC, S.D. Fla., Civil Action No. 93-8034-CIV-ROETTGER] (LR-13517)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JAMES FORS IS SENTENCED

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on January 8, 1993 James H. Fors (Fors) was sentenced by Chief District Court Judge Bruce S. Jenkins to spend five years on probation and to pay a fine of \$1,000.00. During the period of his probation, Fors is expressly prohibited from engaging in stock promotions or in conducting stock sales. Fors is from Bradenton, Florida.

On October 27, 1992, Fors pled guilty to a two-count felony information charging him with securities fraud. During his guilty plea, Fors admitted that he knew of the control and planned market manipulation of the stocks of Walsh Communications Group, Inc. (Walsh) and of Micro-Books International, Inc. (Micro-Books). He further admitted that he promoted and sold the stock when this information was not available to potential and actual investors in the stock of Walsh and of Micro-Books. [U.S. v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AIM CONVERTIBLE SECURITIES, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 8, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by AIM Convertible Securities, Inc. et al. for an exemption under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. Applicants seek an exemption permitting certain investment companies to impose and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. (Rel. UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue. (Rel. 34-31832)

An order has been issued granting the application of the Boston Stock Exchange and the application of the Pacific Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

The Participants Trust Company has filed a notice of a request for temporary registration as a clearing agency (File No. 600-25) under Section 17A of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the request is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-31834)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-06) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange which makes permanent a pilot program that provides a 50% rebate on transaction and trade match fees for "box" trades by public customers in Standard & Poor's 500 Stock Index options has become effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-31836)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-01) that would require members to report all transactions in convertible debt securities listed on NASDAQ. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
