ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

NASD DIRECTED TO BAR DOMINIC PADULA

The Commission issued an order directing the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. to bar Dominic Padula, a person subject to a statutory disqualification, from becoming associated with an NASD member firm that had proposed to employ him. Mr. Padula is subject to a statutory disqualification as a result of his conviction for currency transaction report violations under the Bank Secrecy Act. The NASD had given the Commission notice that it proposed to permit Mr. Padula to become associated with a member firm unless directed otherwise by the Commission. (Rel. 34-32628)

FORMER J.T. MORAN OPERATIONS CHIEF ENJOINED AND BARRED

The Commission announced that it instituted and settled administrative proceedings against Roy M. Sartorius (Sartorius) in which Sartorius consented to the issuance of an order by the Commission which bars him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer and makes findings that he was enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York from violating the antifraud and other provisions of the federal securities laws.

On July 2, the Honorable Thomas P. Griesa permanently enjoined Sartorius from violating the registration, antifraud, antimanipulation, net capital and broker-dealer reporting provisions of the federal securities laws and the margin regulations of the federal securities laws and of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. Sartorius was a Senior Vice-President, Director and the operations chief of J.T. Moran & Co., Inc. (Moran), a "boiler room" broker-dealer which ceased operations in January 1990.

The Commission, in a complaint filed on July 14, sought permanent injunctive relief against six defendants (SEC v. John T. Moran, et al., 92 Civ. 5209, TPG, USDC, SDNY). The complaint alleges, among other things, that in 1988 Sartorius and others, engaged in unlawful securities trading which artificially inflated Moran's net capital position. The complaint also alleges that Sartorius and others assisted in a false closing of an October 1988 offering of MoranFin units and then manipulated aftermarket trading in MoranFin units (LR-13312). INITIAL DECISION DENIES APPLICATION OF COUNSELLORS TANDEM SECURITIES FUND, INC. AND SEQUOIA PARTNERS, L.P. FOR EXEMPTION UNDER THE INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT OF 1940

Administrative Law Judge Edward J. Kuhlmann has issued an initial decision denying the application of Counsellors Tandem Securities Fund, Inc. and Sequoia Partners, L.P. for an exemption under the Investment Company Act of 1940 to permit the Fund, a closed-end investment company, to reimburse Sequoia \$240,000 in expenses incurred in connection with a proxy contest instituted by Sequoia as a means of effecting an opening or liquidation of the Fund.

According to the decision, Sequoia was an "affiliated person" of the Fund under Section 2(a)(3) of the Act. Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 prohibit an affiliated person of a registered investment company from participating in or effecting any transaction in connection with any joint arrangement without prior Commission approval. It was found that the reimbursement of the proxy expenses was over-reaching because the reimbursement gave Sequoia more advantageous treatment in the tender offer over non-affiliated stockholders. The decision also concluded that the applicants' filing was untimely. (Initial Decision Rel. 37)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-93-29) relating to the location on the floor of transactions in bonds. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 19. (Rel. 34-32650)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Depository Trust Corporation which provides for the mandatory use of DTC's Automated Tender Offer Program. (Rel. 34-32645)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Options Clearing Corporation and The Intermarket Clearing Corporation filed proposed rule changes (SR-OCC-93-07 and SR-ICC-93-04) to permit OCC and ICC to restructure their cross-margining program to parallel OCC's cross-margining programs with other clearing organizations. (Rel. 34-32646; International Series Rel. 564)

The Cincinnati Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CSE-93-02) to amend CSE Rule 11.9(a)(8) defining "professional agency orders" to include futures commission merchants and members of contract markets. The proposed rule change relates to an agreement between the CSE and The Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT) allowing joint members to access the CSE's National Securities Trading System (NSTS) via the CBOT's Board of Trade Work Station (BOTWS). Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 19. (Rel. 34-32649)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
