COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SECTION 16 LETTER INDEX BY SUBJECT MATTER

The Division of Corporation Finance has released an index organizing by subject matter Section 16 letters issued through November 30, 1993. The index is updated from time to time and copies of it may be obtained by writing to or by making a request in person at the Public Reference Room, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Room 1024, Washington, D.C. 20549.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

OIL AND GAS PROMOTER SANCTIONED

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings against David M. Beckham, formerly the president of Investamerica Financial Services Corporation (Investamerica), a now defunct broker-dealer, and simultaneously accepted Beckham's Offer of Settlement in which he consented to the issuance of an Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. The bar is based on the entry of an injunction against Beckham by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas (SEC v. Tekna Synergy Corporation, et al. CA No. 4:93-CV-084-A) permanently enjoining him from future violations of the securities registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission's complaint in the related civil action alleges that Beckham and others caused Investamerica to sell approximately \$10 million in oil and gas investments to investors nationwide using fraudulent boiler-room sales practices. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST GENETICS INSTITUTE, INC.

The Commission announced the issuance of Findings and a Cease and Desist Order Pursuant to Section 21C(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Genetics Institute, Inc. of Cambridge, Massachusetts. Genetics consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the findings. The Commission found that Genetics violated Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-1 thereunder. Genetics is engaged in the discovery, development and manufacture of human pharmaceutical products.

The Order contains findings that, for its fiscal year ended November 30, 1990, Genetics failed to classify as "other than temporary" the decline in the market value below the cost basis of its approximately \$8 million investment in the securities of another company. As a result, Genetics understated its losses by \$1.6 million in its fiscal 1990. The Order finds that Genetics should have written down this noncurrent marketable equity security to its realizable value and recognized the corresponding loss in its statement of operations for fiscal 1990. The Commission ordered that Genetics permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation or future violation of Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-1 thereunder. COMMISSION SUSTAINS NASD ACTION AGAINST CONRAD LYSIK

The Commission has sustained the NASD's findings of violation against Conrad C. Lysiak, a compliance officer at Dillon Securities, Inc. (DSI), a former NASD member firm. The NASD censured Lysiak, fined him \$15,000, suspended him from acting in any principal capacity for ten days and required him to requalify by examination as a principal.

The Commission found that Lysiak failed to supervise two traders at DSI's Scottsdale office who engaged in private securities transactions and employed fraudulent and deceptive sales practices. The Commission rejected Lysiak's arguments that he was not the compliance officer in charge of the supervision of the Scottsdale office, that he was only a part-time supervisor and that, at any rate, his supervision was not deficient. Lysiak largely abdicated his supervisory responsibility with respect to Scottsdale and consequently missed "red flags" that might have alerted him to the traders' actions.

In affirming the NASD's sanctions, the Commission noted "the seriousness of Lysiak's supervisory lapses." (Rel. 34-33245)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by the National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its non-utility subsidiary company, Empire Exploration, Inc. (Empire), and Empire's proposed non-utility subsidiary company, KEX, Inc. (KEX), whereby National and Empire will exchange approximately 101,083 shares of National's common stock for substantially all of the assets of KEX and its parent company, Kidder, Inc., and all of the KEX issued and outstanding common stock. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission extended the time period for public comment on a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-93-36) until December 23, 1993. The proposed rule change would amend Section 41 of the Code of Arbitration Procedure to permit parties in arbitration proceedings involving at least \$250,000 to make pre-hearing settlement offers before an arbitration hearing is set to begin. The proposed rule change would require parties who reject such settlement offers to pay the offering party's reasonable costs and attorneys fees if the award granted in the arbitration was not more favorable to the rejecting party than the settlement offer. The proposed rule change would expire after two years. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 29. (Rel. 34-33236)

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-54) to permit the listing and trading of options on American Depositary Receipts (ADRs) where over 50% of the world-wide trading volume in the underlying stocks and ADRs occurs in the U.S. ADR market, even if the Phlx does not have a comprehensive surveillance sharing agreement in place with the foreign exchange on which the foreign security underlying the ADR primarily trades.

The Commission also granted partial accelerated approval to portions of the proposed rule change which provide for the listing and trading of options on ADRs representing shares of Transportacion Maritima Mexicana. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 29. (Rel. 34-33252; International Series Rel. 616)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-93-09) to provide for the listing and trading of options on ADRs representing shares of Transportacion Maritima Mexicana. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 29. (Rel. 34-33253; International Series Rel. 617)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-93-40) to provide for the listing and trading of Stock Upside Note Securities (SUNS) the return of which is based upon a global basket of securities of telecommunications companies. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 29. (Rel. 34-33255; International Series Rel. 618)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
