HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASE

PEOPLES NATURAL GAS RECEIVES ORDER. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act (Release 35-16931) granting an extension to December 31, 1971, of the time in which The Peoples Natural Gas Company ("Peoples"), New York subsidiary of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, may acquire \$37,000 of subordinated debentures of Allegheny Housing Rehabilitation Corporation ("AHRC") (a corporation organized for the purpose of acquiring, rehabilitating and selling or retaining for rent, structurally sound but sub-standard or dilapidated slum housing in the Pittsburgh metropolitan area). In April 1968, the Commission authorized Peoples to acquire 25 shares of common stock at \$1,000 per share and \$75,000 of subordinated debentures of AHRC; to date, Peoples has acquired all the common shares and all but \$37,000 of the debentures.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

PURITAN FUND SEEKS ORDER. The SEC has issued an order under the Investment Company Act (Release IC-6283) giving interested persons until December 24 to request a hearing upon an application of Puritan Fund, Inc., Boston, Mass. for an order exempting it from certain provisions of the Act to enable the Fund to issue its redeemable securities at their net asset value in exchange for substantially all the assets of New England Laundries, Inc. (Laundries). Pursuant to agreement between the Fund and Laundries, the assets of the latter, consisting mostly of common stock and debt securities, will be transferred to the Fund in exchange for shares of Fund stock, which will be distributed to Laundries' shareholders upon its liquidation.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTION

PAUL W. CARLIN SENTENCED. The SEC Fort Worth Regional Office announced December 4 (LR-4841) that the Federal court at Houston sentenced Paul Warner Carlin, Sr., of Houston, to six years' imprisonment on a plea of guilty to a charge of violating the anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in sale of first mortgage bonds of the Paul Carlin Evangelistic Association.

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

CLEVETRUST REALTY PROPOSES OFFERING. CleveTrust Realty Investors, 1525 Investment Plaza, Cleveland, Ohio 44144, filed a registration statement (File 2-38989) with the SEC on December 8 seeking registration of 2,500,000 shares of beneficial interest, with warrants to purchase 2,500,000 additional shares, to be offered for public sale in units, each consisting of one share and one warrant, and at \$20 per unit. The offering is to be made through underwriters headed by Morgan Stanley & Co., 2 Wall St., New York 10005; the underwriting terms are to be supplied by amendment.

The Trust was recently established to provide investors with an opportunity to invest in a portfolio of real property investments which will be selected to produce current income and opportunities for capital appreciation. CleveTrust Advisers will serve as investment adviser and administer the day-to-day operations of the Trust. Everett Ware Smith is chairman and John C. Ketchan president of the Trust.

ALLEGHENY AIRLINES SHARES IN REGISTRATION. Allegheny Airlines, Inc., Washington National Airport, Washington, D. C. 20001, filed a registration statement (File 2-38991) with the SEC on December 8 seeking registration of 12,675 outstanding shares of common stock. Of these shares, 8,935 are issuable upon the exercise of warrants; the remaining 3,740 shares are outstanding and may be offered for sale from time to time by the holders thereof, at prices current at the time of sale (\$10.50 per share maximum*).

The company is a certified air carrier engaged in the business of transporting passengers, property and mail. In addition to indebtedness, it has outstanding 3,170,481 common shares.

CONNECTICUT GAS TO SELL BONDS. Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation, 233 Pearl St., Hartford, Conn., filed a registration statement (File 2-38993) with the SEC on December 8 seeking registration of \$12,000,000 of first mortgage bonds, Series L, due 1996, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Smith, Barney & Co. Inc., 20 Broad St., New York 10005. The interest rate, offering price and underwriting terms are to be supplied by amendment. A public utility, the company will use the net proceeds of its bond sale to repay short-term notes payable to banks (the proceeds of which were used for property additions which, in 1969 and through October 1970 totaled \$10,772,000); any balance will be used to finance 1970-71 construction expenditures. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$11,500,000 for the balance of 1970 and 1971.

PUBLIC SERVICE OF INDIANA TO SELL BONDS. Public Service Company of Indiana, Inc., 1000 East Main St., Plainfield, Ind., 46168, filed a registration statement (File 2-38994) with the SEC on December 9 seeking registration of \$50,000,000 of first mortgage bonds, Series R, to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding. A public utility, the company will use the net proceeds of its bond sale to prepay short-term promissory notes, to reimburse its treasury for funds actually expended on its construction program and to apply the balance toward future construction expenditures. Construction expenditures for the 1971-1975 period are estimated at \$465,000,000.
