## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### CONNECTICUT INVESTMENT ADVISER PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on March 8 Judge Warren E. Eginton, U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut (sitting at Bridgeport, Connecticut) signed an Order of Permanent Injunction against Investment Notes Research Group, Inc. (INRG) and James Joseph Reid. INRG is a registered investment adviser located in New Haven, Connecticut; Reid is the president and majority stockholder of INRG and resides in Guilford Connecticut. The injunction enjoins them from further violations of the antifraud, reporting and recordkeeping provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the margin provisions of the Exchange Act and the credit provisions of Regulation X adopted by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. The defendants consented to the Order of Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint. Previously, on September 21, 1983, Judge Eginton entered Orders of Preliminary Injunction against both defendants.

The Commission alleged, in its September 19, 1983 complaint, that from May 5, 1983 to date INRG, aided and abetted by Reid, defrauded clients by converting their funds to business and personal use, misrepresented SEC regulations to clients, and failed to inform clients that Reid had been terminated by a previous employer for cause. (SEC v. Investment Notes Research Group, Inc. and James Joseph Reid, Dist. of Conn., Civil Action No. N83-498, 1983). (LR-10311)

The provisions of the rule being approved relate to appointment and oversight of market makers while the remainder requires that a minimum portion of a market maker's options transactions be executed in person.
