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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### INTERNATIONAL WASTE WATER MANAGEMENT RECLAMATION TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

The Commission, in this pending case under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, entered into an agreement with the trustee of International Waste Water Management Reclamation Technologies, Inc., Ozonics, Inc., and New Maryland, Inc., resolving the Commission's objections to a proposed transaction involving the issuance of unregistered securities. The Commission had filed objections to the proposed transaction involving the sale of substantially all the debtor's assets on the ground that the transaction contemplated the sale of securities in violation of Section 5 of the Securities Act of 1933 since there is no exemption from registration available under the Securities Act or the Bankruptcy Code [see Rel. CR-337, November 13, 1984].

Under the agreement, made part of the Bankruptcy Judge's order entered December 10, 1984, New Maryland agreed to file a registration statement under the Securities Act respecting the shares to be issued to the trustee, and the trustee agreed that no distribution of shares will be made prior to the registration statement becoming effective. In addition, the trustee agreed to file a plan of reorganization and a disclosure statement prior to the distribution of shares. The Commission agreed to withdraw its objection and motion for intervention under Section 1109(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, upon entry of the order. (Rel. CR-341)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### KENNETH D. OXBORROW ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on December 4 a decree of permanent injunction was entered against Kenneth D. Oxborrow of Moses Lake, Washington by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington with Oxborrow's consent. The injunction, obtained by the Commission in a joint action with the Commodity Futures Trading Commission, enjoined Oxborrow from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities and commodity futures laws. According to Oxborrow's schedules in his pending bankruptcy case in the same district, he had obtained about \$57 million from nearly 1,000 investors. (CFTC, SEC v. Kenneth D. Oxborrow, C-84-811-JLQ, EDWA). (LR-10643)

### PETER P. DHAWAN ENJOINED

The Commission filed a civil action on December 26 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Peter P. Dhawan of Beverly Hills, California, alleging violations of the antifraud, reporting, and accounting records and controls provisions of the securities laws. Without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, Dhawan consented to a Final Judgment permanently restraining and enjoining him from further violations of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that from about September 1981 through March 1983, while chairman and chief executive officer of BTK Industries, Inc., Dhawan artificially inflated BTK's sales and net earnings by means of the improper recognition of revenue on goods ordered by, but not shipped to, a customer. (SEC v. Peter P. Dhawan, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 84-3907). (LR-10646)

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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### ANTHONY MATERIA INDICTED

The New York Regional Office announced that on December 18 a federal grand jury sitting in Manhattan returned a 21-count indictment charging Anthony Materia with trading on the basis of material non-public information acquired during the course of his employment at the printing concern of Bowne of New York City, Inc. The indictment charges

Materia with nine counts of fraud in the purchase and sale of securities, nine counts of fraud in tender offers, and three counts of mail fraud.

Materia was previously enjoined and ordered to disgorge profits in a civil action [SEC v. Materia, 82 Civ. 6225, SDNY, 1983]. The Second Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed the District Court's decision in October 1984 [No. 84-6043; No. 66 August Term 1984]. (U.S. v. Anthony Materia). (LR-10645)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### MIDDLE SOUTH ENERGY, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued regarding the financing of pollution control facilities at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Electric Generating Station by Middle South Energy, Inc. (MSE), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., through the issue and sale by Claiborne County, Mississippi of up to \$206 million in pollution control revenue bonds. This supplemental order releases jurisdiction over the negotiated terms of the financing. (Rel. 35-23545 - Dec. 26)

Another supplemental order has been issued regarding the issue and sale of up to \$300 million of first mortgage bonds by MSE in one or more series through October 31, 1985, by means of a negotiated underwritten offering. This supplemental order releases jurisdiction over the negotiated terms of the financing of up to \$300 million of the bonds. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the negotiated terms of up to \$100 million of bonds. (Rel. 35-23546 - Dec. 26)

### LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Louisiana Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to enter into installment sales agreements with St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, in the financing of pollution control facilities at Waterford Steam Electric Generating Station through the issue and sale by the County of up to \$105 million in pollution control revenue bonds. (Rel. 35-23547 - Dec. 26)

### INTER-CITY GAS CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Inter-City Gas Corporation, an exempt holding company, to purchase the outstanding common stock of Northern and Central Gas Corporation Limited (N&C) and its subsidiaries, Greater Winnipeg Gas Company and Le Gaz Provincial du Nord de Quebec, Ltee., and a request by N&C, Greater Winnipeg and Le Gaz that they be granted exemptions from all of the provisions of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 under Section 3(b). An order has been issued granting the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system.
