CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST WESTERN GUARANTEED INCOME TRUST, SERIES 85-1 AND SERIES 2

The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a Complaint on January 29 against Western Guaranteed Income Trust, Series 85-1; Western Guaranteed Income Trust, Series 2; Cosmolite Capital, Inc.; Cosmolite Securities Corporation; and Frank R. Haynes, charging violations of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the Investment Company Act of 1940. The Complaint alleges numerous violations in connection with two offerings of interests in unit investment trusts including: overstatements of trust assets in prospectuses and annual reports to unitholders; the failure to deposit trust monies with a custodian in contravention of prospectus representations; and the charging of operating fees which greatly exceeded prospectus estimates. Each defendant, without admitting or denying the violations, consented to a permanent injunction against such violations. The Court appointed a disbursing agent to liquidate the trusts and an independent accountancy firm to conduct an accounting. (SEC v. Western Guaranteed Income Trust, Series 85-1, et al., Civ. No. 88-00513 AWT [Tx], CDCA). (LR-11655; AAER-177)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SELECTED INVESTMENT MANAGERS CAPITAL APPRECIATION EQUITY FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 29 to request a hearing on separate applications of Selected Investment Managers Capital Appreciation Equity Fund, Selected Investment Managers Diversified Fixed Income Fund, Selected Investment Managers Income Equity Fund, Selected Investment Managers Tax Exempt Fixed Income Fund, Selected Investment Managers Tax Exempt Money Market Fund, Selected Investment Managers U.S. Government Guaranteed Securities Income Fund, and Selected Investment Managers International Equity Fund for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. MEDALLION FUNDING CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Medallion Funding Corp. for an order exempting it from the provisions of Sections 8(b), 12(d)(1), 12(e), 17(a), 17(d), 18(a), 18(c), 30(b), and 30(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 8b-16, 17d-1, 30b1-1, and 30d-1. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 26 to request a hearing on a proposal by System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), and its parent, Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, whereby SERI will enter into a nuclear-fuel lease and Middle South will guarantee SERI's obligations under the lease. THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued concerning a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries. By order dated December 23, 1987 [Rel. 35-24541], the Commission authorized the extension through December 31, 1989 of the subsidiaries' intercompany financing programs, Columbia's external short-term financing program and the Intrasystem Money Pool, subject to the approval of state commissions having jurisdiction over the proposed transactions. The supplemental order releases jurisdiction over the issuance and sale by Columbia Gas of New York, Inc. of up to 114,000 shares of common stock to Columbia. (Rel. 35-24571 - Feb. 4)

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of RELIANCE GROUP HOLDINGS, INC. to withdraw the 14% senior debentures, due 1996, and the 11-1/2% sinking fund debentures, due December 1, 1997, from listing and registration on the Philadelphia Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-25305)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

DOW CORNING CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 27 to request a hearing on an application by Dow Corning Corporation, a Michigan corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A. under a Dow Corning indenture and under an indenture of Michigan Strategic Fund, the proceeds of which were loaned to Dow Corning under a Loan Agreement between the Fund and Dow Corning, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Citibank from acting as trustee under either such indenture. The indentures are dated April 1, 1975 and August 1, 1987 and the securities outstanding under them are approximately \$15 million of 9-5/8% sinking fund debentures, due April 1, 2005, and \$4 million of adjustable tender solid waste disposal revenue bonds (Dow Corning Corporation Project), Series 1987, respectively.
