COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

LETTER RELEASED SETTING FORTH INTERPRETIVE POSITIONS

The Commission today released a letter to Senators Donald W. Riegle and Alfonse M. D'Amato setting forth certain interpretive positions in a legislative history of the Commission's proposal to define insider trading.

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT C. LABINE SENTENCED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 27 Robert C. LaBine was sentenced by U.S. District Court Judge James P. Churchill to three years imprisonment on each of three counts of mail fraud and one year imprisonment on one count of submitting a false loan application to a federally insured bank. The sentences are to run concurrently, and LaBine will remain free on bond pending appeal. LaBine, after a jury trial, was found guilty on December 8, 1987. (U.S. v. Robert C. LaBine, et al., USDC EDMI, CR 87-80229 DT). (LR-11666)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MUTUAL BENEFIT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Mutual Benefit Life Insurance Company, Mutual Benefit Variable Contract Account-9, and Mutual Benefit Financial Service Company from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of an asset based sales charge and mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Separate Account. (Rel. IC-16266 - Feb. 11)

NATIONWIDE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting the Nationwide Life Insurance Company and Nationwide VLI Separate Account-2 exemptions from Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2), 27(c)(1), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and paragraphs (b)(1), (b)(13)(i)(B), and (c)(4)(ii) of Rule 6e-3(T). The exemptions will permit them to use, for the purpose of sales load computation, the 1958 Commissioner's Standard Ordinary Table, and to allow them to deduct an income tax charge if such taxes are incurred as a result of the operations of the Separate Account, in connection with certain flexible premium variable life insurance policies. TRIDENT MORTGAGE SECURITIES COMPANY

An order has been issued on an application filed by Trident Mortgage Securities Company (Applicant), a limited purpose Delaware subsidiary of Trident Financial Corporation, on behalf of itself and all owner trusts (each, a Trust), and partnerships (each, a Partnership) it may establish in the future. The application exempts Applicant, and each Trust and Partnership (collectively, Issuing Affiliates), from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of mortgage-backed bonds, and the sale of residual interests in the Issuing Affiliates. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, SV Ventures, Inc., whereby Southern will acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Savannah Electric and Power Company (SEPCO), a publicly-owned electric utility. SV will then be merged with and into SEPCO. SEPCO will continue to operate as an electric utility company and will be a separate subsidiary of Southern. (Rel. 35-24579 - Feb. 12)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 3 to comment on the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in five issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of BRT REALTY TRUST to withdraw shares of beneficial interest, \$3.00 par value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-25345)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-1) that will reinstate the effectiveness of its "Procedures for Competing Specialists" until April 30, 1988. (Rel. 34-25342)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-88-1) to amend its constitution to require an affirmative membership vote for the issuance of permits or other rights that grant holders access to its trading floor for the purpose of effecting securities transactions. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-25344)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
