U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

RULE 23(E) ADOPTED

The Commission adopted Rule 23(e), amending its Rules of Practice, to designate its Secretary as the officer to receive copies of petitions for review of Commission orders. The rule was adopted under 28 U.S.C. 2112(a)(2), which requires that agencies notify the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation when two or more petitions for review are filed in different courts of appeals within ten days of the order. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

The hearing on financial planners scheduled for Tuesday, July 26 will begin at 10:00 a.m. in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. As previously announced, David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, and Kathryn B. McGrath, Director of the Division of Investment Management, will testify before the Consumer Affairs Subcommittee of the Senate Banking Committee.

EDWARD KOHLER PROMOTED TO SENIOR TRIAL COUNSEL (ENFORCEMENT)

Chicago Regional Office (CRO) Administrator, William D. Goldsberry, announced the promotion of Edward Kohler from Chief, Branch of Enforcement, to Senior Trial Counsel (Enforcement).

Mr. Kohler graduated from the University of Illinois, Champagne/Urbana, with a Bachelor's Degree in 1974 and a Masters in Business Administration in 1976 and from Loyola University of Chicago College of Law with a Juris Doctorate Degree in 1978. After graduation, he joined the CRO as an enforcement staff lawyer and was promoted to branch chief in 1984. Additionally, during the past few years, Mr. Kohler worked extensively with the Department of Justice, Organized Crime and Racketeering Section, Chicago Strike Force.

CORPORATE REORGANIZATION RELEASES

GLOBAL MARINE, INC.

The Commission announced that on July 7 in the Chapter 11 reorganization case of Global Marine, Inc. the bankruptcy Court, agreeing with the Commission's position, ordered the appointment of an additional official committee to represent the interests of subordinated debentureholders. The mandatory unsecured creditors' committee, which had represented both debentureholders and general unsecured creditors, had become deadlocked over the terms of the proposed plan of reorganization, which would treat general creditors different from the debentureholders. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENTS OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF ENTERED AGAINST CHARLES SCHEUERMAN, OTHERS

Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief were entered against Charles Scheuerman, Mary Armeni, Jerome Tepps, and Michael Goldstein by U.S. District Court Judge Nicholas Bua, Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division. They consented to the Final Judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, filed on January 12. Final Judgments by Default were also entered by Judge Bua against Vanguard Financial, Inc., Chatsworth Enterprises, Inc., and Transworld Network Corporation in the same matter.

The Complaint alleges violations and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, registration, and reporting provisions of the securities laws. It also alleges that all defendants engaged in a scheme to defraud, involving creating and covertly controlling the five defendant companies raising money through blind pool offering using false Forms S-18 registration statements, misappropriating money, and engaging in kickback schemes.

Defendants were also charged with violating or aiding and abetting violations of Section 6(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 in that certain signatures were affixed to registration statements filed with the Commission without authorization. (SEC v. Carl Porto, et al., NDIL, Civil Action No. 88 C 0239). (LR-11805)

An order has been issued declaring that Massmutual Equity Investors Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16486 - July 20)

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Big Marsh Oil Company and Columbia Natural Resources, Inc. (CNR), whereby Columbia will transfer 870 shares of Big Marsh common stock, par value \$100, to CNR in exchange for 3,480 shares of CNR common stock, par value \$25, to effect a merger of Big Marsh into CNR.
