ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS DISMISSED

The Commission issued an order dismissing proceedings against Kelly N. Trimble, of Salt Lake City, Utah. The proceedings were instituted by Commission order on March 26, 1987. The proceedings were dismissed without prejudice to reinstitution, and each party was ordered to bear its own attorneys' fees and costs of litigation. Trimble consented to the dismissal. (Rel. 34-25931)

WORLDWIDE INVESTMENT RESEARCH, LTD. REGISTRATION REVOKED; PAUL K. KOERNER PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Commission ordered the registration of Worldwide Investment Research, Ltd. as an investment adviser to be revoked and ordered Paul K. Koerner to be permanently barred from association with any investment adviser. Neither Worldwide nor Koerner filed an answer to the Commission's Order Instituting Public Proceedings under Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act which was entered on June 15.

The Secretary found, based on the Order, that from August 1982 to the present, Worldwide was a registered investment adviser and Koerner an associated person of Worldwide; and that Worldwide and Koerner willfully violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws by offering and selling unregistered securities in the form of platinum accounts and by making material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the securities. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES GEOFFREY W. COLLIER AND MICHAEL B. CASSELL

The Commission filed an action on July 26 in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Geoffrey W. Collier and Michael B. Cassell. The Complaint alleges that they violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 through trading in the securities of Associated Engineering, PLC and Cadbury-Schweppes, PLC.

The Complaint alleges that Collier, then a managing director of Morgan Grenfell Securities, Ltd., obtained material non-public information concerning potential acquisitions of AE and Cadbury and, while in possession of that information, purchased AE shares and Cadbury options on the London Stock Exchange. Collier traded through Cassell, who was then associated with an American broker-dealer. The Commission alleges that Cassell knew, or was reckless in not knowing, that Collier was in possession of information obtained from Morgan Grenfell in breach of a duty of trust and confidence. Collier and Cassell consented to a Final Judgment enjoining them from violating the antifraud provisions in the future. (SEC v. Geoffrey W. Collier and Michael B. Cassell, USDC CDCA, Civil Action No. 88-4505 WMB, GHK). (LR-11817)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JAMES L. CONDRON PLEADS GUILTY

The Boston Regional Office announced that on July 14 James L. Condron of Wilton, Connecticut pleaded guilty to an Information charging him with mail fraud in connection with his management of five limited partnerships which were engaged in a securities trading scheme which partnerships were advised and managed by Condron.

The criminal charges follow an investigation and a civil injunctive action brought by the Commission. The civil action resulted in a permanent injunction against, among others, Condron, and in the appointment of a receiver for the limited partnerships, which receivership is still pending. (U.S. v. James L. Condron, B-88-27, TFGD). (LR-11810)

FREDERICK LAWRENCE SENTENCED

The Atlanta Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney in Greensboro, North Carolina announced that on July 8 Frederick R. Lawrence of West End, North Carolina was sentenced to six months imprisonment for the fraudulent offer and sale of unregistered securities. U.S. District Judge Richard C. Erwin, Middle District of North Carolina, found Lawrence guilty of criminal contempt of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction entered against in 1982 [SEC v. Longleaf, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 82-411-G, USDC MDNC]. The injunction restrained him from offering and selling unregistered securities and from making material misrepresentations and omissions in connection with such sales. Lawrence was found to have sold over \$12 million in securities to over 500 investors in violation of the injunction. (U.S. v. Frederick R. Lawrence, Criminal No. 88-62-5, USDC MDNC). (LR-11811)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CU MEMBERS INCOME FUND, LTD.

An order has been issued declaring that CU Members Income Fund, Ltd. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16493 - July 22)

SUN LIFE FINANCE CORPORATION, INC.

An order has been issued permitting Sun Life Finance Corporation to offer and sell non-voting preferred stock to finance the business operations of its parent and subsidiaries thereof. (Rel. IC-16494 - July 22)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Midwest Stock Exchange - five issues. (Rel. 34-25939); and the Philadelphia Stock Exchange - five issues. (Rel. 34-25940)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change by The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-18) to provide for a one-year pilot program during which public customers may apply for an exemption from broad-based index option position limits for positions that are hedged against qualified stock portfolios. (Rel. 34-25938)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by the Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia (SR-SCCP-87-4) and the Philadelphia Depository Trust Company (SR-Philadep-87-1) which authorizes them to impose minor disciplinary sanctions (fines up to \$250) on their participants that fail to confirm in a timely manner the accuracy of their monthly account statements. (Rel. 34-25941)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-88-10) to trade Equity Index Participations based on the S&P 500 Index in addition to the Amex Major Market Index. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 25. (Rel. 34-25942)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
