ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REPLACEMENT COST IMPLEMENTATION MEETING ANNOUNCED

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN DIVERSIFIED INDUSTRIES, INC.

The SEC has announced the temporary suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Diversified Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation located in Clayton, Missouri, for the ten-day period beginning on June 10 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on June 19, 1976.
