# COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES AND

COMMISSION SEEKS REVIEW OF DECISION IN DUPONT-CHRISTIANA MERGER RULING

EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Commission announced that the Solicitor General has agreed to seek Supreme Court review of the decision of the Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit setting aside the order of the Commission which, on December 13, 1974, had permitted a proposed merger of Christiana Securities Company and E. I. DuPont de Nemours & Company. The court of appeals set aside the Commission's order by a 2 to 1 opinion on January 23, and the Commission's petition for rehearing and suggestion for rehearing en banc were denied by the court of appeals by an equally-divided court on February 26. The time for the Commission to file its petition for a writ of certiorari to the Supreme Court has been extended to June 25.

## STAFF ACCOUNTING BULLETIN NO. 9 PUBLISHED

The Division of Corporation Finance and the Office of the Chief Accountant announced the publication of Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 9. The statements in the Bulletin are not rules or interpretations of the Commission nor are they published as bearing the Commission's official approval; they represent interpretations and practices followed by the Division and the Chief Accountant in administering the disclosure requirements of the securities laws. Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 9 provides interpretations of Accounting Series Release No. 190. This release (the adoption of Rule 3-17 of Regulation S-X [17 CFR 210.3-17]) requires the disclosure of replacement cost data by certain registrants effective for years ending on or after December 25. ### TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN VIKING GENERAL CORP.

The SEC announced the single suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Viking General Corp. (Viking) located in Miami, Florida, for the ten-day period beginning on June 17 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on June 26. The Commission ordered the suspension at the request of the company because of questions concerning the accuracy and adequacy of information about Viking currently available to the public including questions concerning the company's land sales operations in Florida. #### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. The rule change (SR-NYSE-76-25) amends Exchange Rules 409, 416, 417, 418 and 440 in order to adopt the FOCUS Report. (Rel. 34-12550)
