JAMES T. BAKOS, TERESA DEL RIO, NAZIR SELIM ANTOUN AND EWING Y. MITCHELL SANCTIONED

# U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Commission has permanently barred James T: Bakos of Los Angeles, California, from association with any broker or dealer, investment company or investment adviser. In addition, the Commission has barred Teresa Del Rio of Los Angeles, California, from association with any broker or dealer, investment company or investment adviser as a principal or supervisor provided that after 30 months she may apply for association in such a position upon a showing that she will be properly supervised. The Commission has also barred Nazir Selim Antoun of Arcadia, California from association with any broker or dealer, investment company or investment adviser provided that after 13 months he may apply for association upon a showing that he will be properly supervised. The Commission has suspended Ewing Y. Mitchell of Rancho Santa Fe, California, from association with any broker or dealer, investment company or investment adviser for a period of 90 days.

Such sanctions were based on findings that (1) Bakos, Del Rio, Antoun and Mitchell wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws; (2) Bakos, Del Rio and Mitchell wilfully violated the registration provisions of the securities laws; (3) Antoun wilfully violated the bookkeeping provisions of the securities laws; and (4) Del Rio and Antoun failed to reasonably supervise persons under their supervision.

Bakos, Del Rio, Antoun and Mitchell consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the charges against them. (Rel. 34-12545)

#### ORDERS FOR PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS

SERECO, S.A., OTHERS

Public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Company Act of 1940 have been ordered against Sereco, S.A., Alfredo Leyzaola C. (Leyzaola) and Benjamin Fernandez F. (Fernandez). Sereco, a Mexican corporation, is registered with the Commission as an investment adviser. Leyzaola and Fernandez are directors of Sereco and its president and treasurer, respectively.

The Commission's order alleges that the respondents variously violated or aided and abetted violations of the registration, broker-dealer, and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford the respondents an opportunity to offer any defenses. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the allegations are true, and if any action of a remedial nature should be ordered by the Commission. (Rel. 34-12584)

## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

INITIAL DECISION REVOKES BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION OF LAMB BROTHERS, INC.; IMPOSES SANCTIONS AGAINST CLYDE C. LAMB, JR.

Chief Judge Warren E. Blair has filled an initial decision under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ordering the revocation of the broker-dealer registration of Lamb Brothers, Inc., of Portland, Oregon, expulsion of the firm from membership in the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., and a bar of its president, Clyde C. Lamb, Jr., from association with any broker or dealer, except that at any time after the effective date of the order he may apply to the Commission for permission to become associated with a broker-dealer in a non-proprietary and non-supervisory position wherein his activities would receive adequate supervision. The decision is subject to review by the Commission either on its own motion or on petition of a party.

Registrant was found to have wilfully violated the Commission's net capital and financial reporting rules and its president was found to have wilfully aided and abetted those violations. Registrant and its president were also found to have been permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon from engaging in, or aiding and abetting, violations of the Commission's net capital rule or failing to file timely reports of registrant's financial condition.

REGULATION A EXEMPTION OF W.E. HAUCK, INC. TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

An order has been issued temporarily suspending the Reg A exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, with respect to the offering of securities of W.E. Hauck, Inc. (the Issuer). Pursuant to a notification filed on October 31, 1975, the Issuer proposed to offer 425,000 shares of common stock, for cash at \$1.00 per share, 52,000 shares of common stock in exchange for common stock in Reid-Provident Laboratories, Inc., and 25,000 shares of common stock for certain assets of American Research Laboratories, Inc. The Atlanta firm of ETI Corporation was to serve as underwriter for the offering. No shares, however, have yet to be sold pursuant to the Regulation A exemption, nor has the Atlanta Regional Office cleared the filing.

According to the order, the Commission has reason to believe that: (a) the notification and offering circular of the Issuer contain untrue statements of material facts and omit to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made not misleading, with respect to, among other things, the failure to disclose the use of a solicitation letter containing misleading statements prior to filing of the notification and offering circular and the failure to disclose that the Commission had not given preliminary approval to the Issuer's offering, as falsely stated in the solicitation letter; (b) the terms and conditions of Regulation A have not been complied with in that, among other things, the offering would exceed the \$500,000 ceiling limitation imposed under Rule 254; and (c) the offering, if made, would be in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. REGULATION A EXEMPTION OF TAXPAYERS AID SOCIETY, INC. TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

An order has been issued temporarily suspending the Regulation A exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, with respect to the offering of short term promissory notes with an aggregate value of \$500,000 of Taxpayers Aid Society, Inc. (the Issuer). According to the order, the Commission has reason to believe that: (a) the Issuer's notification and offering circular contain untrue statements of material facts and omit to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made not misleading, with respect to, among other things, the failure to disclose the Issuer's sales of securities in violation of the Securities Act of 1933 pursuant to false and misleading statements and the failure to provide financial statements required by Regulation A; (b) the terms and conditions of Regulation A have not been complied with, in that, among other things, the Issuer is subject to an order of permanent injunction issued by a Federal District Court, enjoining securities laws violations; and (c) the offering, if made, would be in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. ## **COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS**

COMPLAINT NAMES STANLEY M. COOPER,
MARY GOEKE BACKSMAN, STANLEY M. COOPER ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 17 a civil injunctive complaint was filed in the Federal District Court in Cincinnati, Ohio, against Stanley M. Cooper and Mary Goeke Backsman, both of Cincinnati, for violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of shares of beneficial interest, certificates of indebtedness, debentures, common stock and preferred stock in various entities purportedly located in Ohio and Kentucky. Also on June 17, a final judgment of permanent injunction by consent was entered by the Honorable Timothy S. Hogan against Stanley M. Cooper in this matter. Cooper was enjoined from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Stanley M. Cooper, Mary Goeke Backsman, S.D. Ohio, Civil No. C-1-76-308).
