

<b>SUSPENSION OF A PROTOCOL ACTIVITY</b>	The IACUC may suspend a previously-approved protocol activity. [2.31]
<b>Criteria</b>	<p>The IACUC may suspend an activity that it previously approved if it determines that the activity is <b>not</b> being conducted as: [2.31(d)(6)]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• described by the principal investigator, AND</li><li>• approved by the IACUC</li></ul> <p>The IACUC may suspend an activity <b>only</b>: [2.31(d)(6)]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• after review of the matter at a convened meeting, and</li><li>• if a quorum of the IACUC is present, and</li><li>• with a vote for suspension by a majority of the quorum present</li></ul> <p>If the IACUC suspends an activity involving animals, the Institutional Official, in consultation with the IACUC, must: [2.31(d)(7)]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• review the reasons for the suspension</li><li>• take appropriate corrective action</li><li>• report that action with a full explanation to:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▶ the appropriate Animal Care Regional Office, and</li><li>▶ any Federal agency funding that activity</li></ul></li></ul>
