SUMMARY:

This was the second meeting of the Standards Technical Panel (STP) on Household Electric Ranges. The objective of the STP is to act as a consensus body, which contributes to the development, maintenance and improvement of UL 858 (*Standard of Safety for Household Electric Ranges*). Minutes of the meeting will be issued by UL. The UL 858 STP chairman is Don Grob of UL, and the Secretary is Amy Walker.

Don Grob briefly discussed the results of a ballot that UL had circulated to the STP members in August 2000 to decide the approach that the STP would take towards the cooktop fire issue. The two
