SUMMARY OF MEETING: Messrs. McLaurin and King were invited to attend the UL Industry Advisory Conference meeting where discussion took place with regard to the new UL requirements for deep fat fryers.

The following topics were discussed at the meeting:

- the status of UL's file review program for deep fat fryers, cooker/fryers and fondues. Effective Date: May 30, 2001.

- input relative to "related risks" associated with the new requirement for detachable cords. This included potential mouth burns to children. UL indicated that they examine product submittals with this in mind, and will address the possibility of additional requirements if warranted.

- magntic coupling technology to other counter top cooking appliances. Ul

indicated that they have no current plans in this regard.

UL summarized that the May 30, 2001 effective date is firm.
