Mr. King participated in discussions of comments received by the NFPA on proposals to revise the 1999 edition of the National Electrical Code, Articles 422, 424, and 680. The new edition will be known as the 2002 edition. The topics covered included appliances, fixed electric space-heating equipment, swimming pools and spas.

The proposals are included in the "National Electrical Code Committee Report on Proposals", recently published by NFPA for the 2001 May Association Technical Meeting. Action on comments taken at the meeting in Phoenix will be published by NFPA in a report on comments prior to the May 2001 NFPA Association Meeting.
