## **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The work group met and revised several of the proposed requirements for the voluntary safety standard. The draft of proposals provided by Mr. Coughlin on May 15, 2001 was used as a working document. A nuisance tripping test and a strain relief test was added to the proposed requirements. The battery charging requirements will be rewritten to address concerns for the battery feeding a fault in the charger or charger wires.

The work group agreed in principle to move the proposed requirements with some agreement forward to ASTM for balloting. The work group chairman will make editorial revisions and send to members of the BPRO work group for additional comments before the proposals are submitted to ASTM for balloting.
