SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The work group met and revised several of the proposed requirements for the voluntary safety standard. The workgroup had agreement on adding flammability requirements for the switches and battery connectors. The workgroup also agreed in principal on requirements for battery charging including "back feed" protection and battery over charging tests.

Additional issues that still need to be addressed are environmental pre-conditioning, nuisance. tripping/ tamper resistant over current protection, stalled motor testing, and strain relief testing. The work group will reconvene in January.
