SUMMARY OF MEETING: CPSC requested a meeting with the representatives of the CCA wood treatment industry to discuss their views and receive pertinent data on the petition before the Commission to ban CCA treated wood for playground equipment. Meeting was opened by Ron Medford, Assistant Executive Director for Hazard Identification and Reduction, CPSC, who discussed the history of the petition before the agency. He also discussed ongoing work on a study protocol that is being developed with US EPA that will be made available to the public in the near future.

Scott Ramminger, President of the American Wood Preservers Institute (AWPI), presented some statistics on the amount of wood that is treated with CCA in U.S., the treatment process, and types of CCA wood. He discussed the usefulness of CCA treated wood as well as alternatives to CCA (copper azole and ACQ), which are more expensive than CCA.

Has Shah, American Chemistry Council (ACC), and John Butala, consulting toxicologist for ACC, presented scientific information about CCA in separate presentations. Dr. Shah stated that ACC has asked Exponent, a consulting firm, to review the data and to provide ACC with recommendations that will form the basis of a risk assessment.

Barbara Beck, Gradient Corporation, presented the results of a risk assessment that was performed by Gradient.


