SUMMARY OF MEETING: Mr. Kopelman provided the CPSC staff with an update on the development of the Firefighter Products line of wiring devices for electrical circuits. The product line includes adapters, duplex receptacles, power strips and appliance/extension cords. The products incorporate a thermal sensor switch to remove electrical power in the event of an over-temperature condition. Prototype versions of the products are presently being fabricated. Mr. Kopelman

indicated that he would provide CPSC staff with technical documentation covering an independent laboratory safety evaluation of the products when it is available.
