### Summary

D13.55.01 TG discussed the revision of ASTM standard D4910-89. The revised standard extends to size 24 months (from 18 months). The standard has been balloted by the subcommittee. Editorial comments were discussed; there were no negative comments. The standard will be balloted to the Main Committee before the next ASTM meeting in the Fall of 1995.

D13.55.03 TG discussed the development of a new standard table of body measurements for children sizes 2-6x. Editorial comments were discussed; there were no negative comments. The standard will be balloted to the subcommittee before the next ASTM meeting in the Fall of 1995.

In addition, a new task group was developed to develop a standard table of body measurements for children sizes 7-14. Task group chairman were selected. The first meeting of the task group will be at the next ASTM meeting in the Fall of 1995.
