SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Representatives from the Chemical Specialty Manufacturers Association (CSMA) met with CPSC staff to discuss the petroleum distillate and ammonia projects. The staff is collecting information about consumer products that contain these chemicals before proceeding with a recommendation to require child-resistant packaging. The CPSC staff wrote to several trade associations requesting information and a meeting with interested parties. The staff is interested in learning about the types of products that contain these chemicals and the markets for these products. The staff is in the process of drafting a Federal Register notice requesting information on petroleum distillates for Commission consideration. The CSMA said that they would discuss these issues with the member companies.
