SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The meeting was an introductory courtesy call requested by Heather Paul of SAFE KIDS.

Ms. Paul provided Commissioner Moore and his staff with packets of information on the National SAFE KIDS Campaign and explained the structure and background of the Safe Kids organization. Ms. Paul also indicated that the National SAFE KIDS Campaign stands ready to support the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) in protecting programs that protect children and provided that the organization had written letters to Congress which expressed support for the mission of CPSC and support for sufficient funding to enable the agency to continue its mission of protecting children.

Mr. Korn indicated that SAFE KIDS had assumed a very action posture with respect to CPSC's Fiscal Year 1996 appropriation.

The meeting was concluded with Commissioner Modre expressing his appreciation for the organization's support and indicating that the prevention of unintentional injuries to kids was a very high priority with him.
