Summary of Meeting:

Susan Kyle was a guest at a regular meeting of the American Academy of Pediatrics Committee on Sports Medicine and Fitness. An agenda and list of committee members is attached.

Susan Kyle gave a brief introduction to the Consumer Product Safety Commission and described the status of its current project on youth baseball protective equipment. She noted that the types of protective equipment under consideration by the CPSC were "soft" baseballs and softballs, chest protectors for batters, batting helmet face guards, and safety release bases. She asked for a recommendation for an individual who is expert on the issue of impact injuries, particularly chest impact injuries, who could serve as a consultant to CPSC on the issue of soft baseballs and chest protectors. Dr. Reginald Washington indicated that he might be interested in serving such a function. Dr. Kyle also mentioned that the committee might be interested in working with ASTM to help to set standards for athletic equipment for children. She agreed to supply the committee with additional information about ASTM for their next meeting.
