SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL: Mr. Quinn called to discuss the status of the CPSC mitigation study for CCA wood. I told him that the study was not yet completed and that we do not have data that we can share with him at this time. I suggested that he call Jacqueline Ferrante, mitigation project manager, if he wanted information that had been released about the study. He expressed concern about what message would go to the public once the study is completed. Mr. Quinn also discussed the status of the acid copper chromate (ACC) registration at EPA and the concerns that Osmose has with this registration. Mr. Quinn will send me some articles that might be of interest on ACC.
