SUMMARY OF MEETING: Meeting with representatives of the Association of Home

Appliance Manufacturers (AHAM) to discuss Section 15 reporting requirements HAM suggested that the current reporting guidelines could be revised to be more predictable and effective. AHAM suggested that the CPSC harmonize, where appropriate, CPSC's reporting system with the new European Union (EU) regulatory regime and cited various provisions of the EU guidelines such as those related to consumer misuse and obviousness of a hazard; adequacy of warnings and instructions; and a manufacturer's due diligence. AHAM also suggested that the CPSC reporting guidelines could be revised to allow for consideration of known failure rates of a product to the CPSC and the manufacturer. In addition, AHAM suggested that the CPSC adopt a formal internal administrative appeals process for hazard determinations. AHAM also suggested a formula based penalty policy. Finally, Wal-mart's new policy on Section 15 reporting

was discussed.
