SUMMARY OF MEETING: Dr. Hatlelid provided a brief overview of CPSC and its activities relating to lead in consumer products, particularly the recently published advance notice of proposed rulemaking concerning lead in children's metal jewelry. Other agenda items included a briefing on potential Maryland legislation concerning lead, a discussion of technology for rapid assessment of blood lead levels, and the availability of information and resources relating to childhood lead poisoning prevention. At the close of the meeting, a Prince George's county representative extended an invitation to Dr. Hatlelid to speak at the county's upcoming lead awareness seminar.
