SUMMARY OF MEETING:

This meeting was held at the request of Rexam Closures. Rexam Closures is one of the firms developing SF child resistant packaging tubes, for products that contain lidocaine. The purpose of this meeting was to determine where the company is in the development of a SF tube special package.

Mr. Robinson, Rexam Closures showed samples of a IIA ASTM lug type child resistant senior friendly cap on a laminated tube (approximately 1 oz). Protocol test results were presented that indicated the package was SF and child resistant.
