Summary: This was the initial meeting in forming an interagency working group to develop a criteria report for glove use in different occupational settings. All parties agreed that information on the utility of various types of gloves in different occupational settings is seriously deficient and there are major data gaps. Considerable information may be available from in house studies of manufacturers and from the ASTM. A list of questions was distributed to participants to begin compiling information on available data and data resources. It was suggested that research money may need to be allocated to develop and conduct tests related to actual occupational use scenarios. Another meeting is planned for August.

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
