

[Proposed class or classes of copyrighted work(s) to be exempted]= Audiovisual works included in a library of a college or university, when circumvention is accomplished for the purpose of making compilations of portions of those works for educational use in the classroom by professors.

[Brief summary of the argument(s) in support of the exemption proposed above]= In the previous Section 1201 rulemaking, the Library of Congress granted an exemption for "[a]udiovisual works included in the educational library of a college or university's film or media studies department, when circumvention is accomplished for the purpose of making compilations of portions of those works for educational use in the classroom by media studies or film professors." This exemption should now be broadened in two important related ways. First, it should apply to audiovisual works included in any college or university library, not just the library of the media studies department. Second, the exemption should apply to classroom uses by instructors in all subjects, not just media studies or film professors.
