- (1) On-line sampling service includes Mechanical Diverter, Ellis Cup or Pelican and will be assessed the appropriate hourly rate for the time involved in the request for service. No unit fee will be assessed.
- (2) Each unit will be assessed the appropriate hourly rate for the time involved in the request for service in addition to the unit fee.
- (3) Submitted sample inspections will be assessed the overtime hourly rate in addition to the regular fee for submitted sample inspection whenever the applicant requests that submitted samples be inspected during overtime hours.
