GRAIN INSPECTION FEES

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2002. This revised fee schedule supersedes all other fee schedules issued by this agency. FGIS supervision fees are included in fees. The Utah Legislature and Federal Grain Inspection Service approve fees for services provided by this agency and are required to assess the fees stated below.

REGULAR HOURS: considered overtime

7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except holidays. All other hours will be

REGULAR AND OVERTIME HOURLY RATES: Regular hourly rate \$24.50 per hour and overtime hourly rate \$36.75 per hour. All hourly rates will be assessed in half-hour increments; overtime rates will be assessed in addition to unit fees. Travel time and standby time for all applicant caused delays will be assessed at the applicable hourly rate. Actual travel time will be assessed outside of a 30-mile radius of Ogden.

HOLIDAYS: Holidays are considered overtime hours and include New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

MILEAGE:

 $0.34 \frac{1}{2}$ per mile for actual miles traveled outside Ogden corporate limits.
