How to Apply:

To apply you must complete an application for Driver Licence/ID Card (MV-44) available at all Erie County Auto Bureaus and at www.nysdmv.com

Proof of Identity:

You Must provide: Original Birth Certificate

Original Social Security Card Parent(s) Signature and Parent(s) Identification (N.Y.S. Drivers License)

Cost for child: \$9.50 - \$10.00 (depending on date of birth)
